# 12,637 Families getting benefits of CM COVID Special Package in Ambassa

Benefits of Chief Minister COVID Special Package are being given to deserving families in Ambassa subdivision of Dhalai distirct. A total of 12,637 families are to get these benefits comprising food kits and Rs. 1000 into their bank accounts. SDM J.B. Doati informed, beneficiary families are getting masoor dal, mustard oil, soya bean, turmeric powder, cumin powder etc. through 41 ration shops. In addition, cash benefit against 3 kg. potato and 2 kg. onion is being transferred into their accounts.

## Fruit saplings & seeds distributed in Mayachhari Panchayat of Kamalpur

Under the Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana vegetable seeds and saplings were distributed among 591 families of Mayachhari panchayat under Kamalpur subdivision on July 3. This initiative was taken by the agriculture and farmers' welfare department. The distribution programme was inaugurated by the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs minister Manoj Kanti Deb.

Addressing the gathering the minister said, both the central and state

governments are implementing various schemes for the economic development of farmers. As part of their initiative the central government is purchasing paddy from the farmers through FCI. Pineapples, lemon etc. fruits of the state are being sent to foreign countries, thereby farmers are getting good prices for their produces. To facilitate marketing of agro-products Kisan Rail has been launched. He also said that Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana is an initiative towards attaining self-reliance.

The programme was also attended by Panchayat Pradhan Saraswati Debnath, Upa-Pradhan Sabyasachi Goala, BDO Amaresh Barman and other officials. In this programme each family received four lemon saplings, five papaya saplings and six Sabri banana saplings.

## Fingerlings distributed under Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in Bagafa

Under the Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana fingerlings of Rui, Katla etc. fishes were distributed among the fish farmers of Rajapur village under Bagafa block on July 3. The fingerling distribution programme was inaugurated by MLA Pramode Reang. In that programme 20

fish farmers were given 500 fingerlings each. Under the initiative total 197 fish farmers of Rajapur village will receive such assistance.

### Water connections in Dasda block under Atal Jaldhara Mission

With the initiative of drinking water and sanitation department, clean drinking water connection is being given in Dasda block area of Kanchanpur subdivision. 320 families have been given drinking water supply through pipelines under Atal Jaldhara Mission in the present fiscal year. In the 2020-21 fiscal year, 1 thousand 826 families and in the 2019-20 fiscal year 3 thousand 405 families were given water connections. This was informed by the water and sanitation department office.

### Ponds excavated in Karbook and Silachari under RKVY

In 2022-21 fiscal year under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana, six new ponds in Karbook block area and two new ponds in Silachari block area have been excavated with the initiative of fisheries department's Karbook sub division office. Excavation of one new pond in Karbook and one new pond in Silachari block is under progress. Training for fish farming

will be given in 2021-22, under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana to 637 fish farmer families in Karbook block, 226 families of Silachari block and 500 fish fingerlings will be distributed to each family. Among them 80 families are of South Karbbok village, 80 of West Karbook village, 80 of Jalaya village, 80 of Ichachari village, 75 of South Ekchari village, 75 of Salka Karbook village, 87 of Laungang village, 80 of Rambhadra village of Karbook block and 76 families of Ghhorakappa village, 75 of Kaptali village, 75 of Bogachetol village of Silachari block. Total 7 lakh 7 thousand 660 rupees is the expenditure. This was informed by Jadulal Saha, fisheries officer, Karbook sub division office.

#### Mandays generated under MGNREGA in Dasda block

So far 63 thousand 858 mandays were generated in the present fiscal year under MGNREGA in Dasda block. Total expenditure was 1 crore 4 lakh 30 thousand rupees. Under this roads were constructed, land levelling was done, other works including building water irrigation canals etc. were done. This was informed by Dasda Block office.
