MoU signed for opening hotel management institute in state

With the objective of opening State Institute of Hotel Management (SIHM) at Agartala a MoU was signed between Tripura Tourism Development Corporation and Infovalley Educational Research Private Limited, Guwahati, at Geetanjali Guest House, Agartala on October 4. On behalf of TTDC, MD Tarit Kanti Chakma and chairman Sanjay Aditya Singh on behalf of Infovalley Educational Research Private Limited signed the MoU in presence of the tourism minister Pranajit Singha Roy. This MoU was signed for a tenure of 15 years.

The State Institute of Hotel Management will open in January, 2022 with a short term course. Degree courses will be started only from April, 2022. In the first year of Hotel and Hospitality degree course and Hotel Management degree course intake capacity will be 60 students. In addition diploma courses like Food and Production, Food and Beverage Services, Bakery and Confectionary, Front Office

Operations and Housing Keeping will have 30 seats each in the first year.

The tourism minister Pranajit Singha Roy thanked Infovalley Educational Research Private Limited for coming forward to open this institute. He said, Prime Minister Narendra Modi and chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb have been sincere to the development of tourism sector. And this new educational institute will play a significant role in the development of tourism sector in the state. He said, the state government and TTDCL would extend their all possible help to make this institute run.

At the programme Sanjay Aditya Singh gave a PowerPoint presentation on the activities and plans of the company. He said, this institute, apart from administrative works, will look after the academic, training and employment aspects of the students. Welcome address was given by MD of TTDCL Tarit Kanti Chakma. The programme was also attended by Pankaj Debbarma on behalf of Infovalley and joint director Dilip Debbarma from TTDCL.
