

Water bodies created in Bharatchandranagar block for pisciculture

Ponds have been created for six beneficiaries of Bharatchandranagar block for fish farming under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana in the previous financial year. Through this, 1 Ha land of the block has been brought under fish farming at the cost of 4 lakh 16 thousand rupees. Apart from that, the beneficiaries were provided with fish fingerlings along with fish feed. 2 lakh rupees was spent for this. This was informed by Fisheries department, Rajnagar office.

Paver block road in Bharatchandranagar block under MGNREGA

To improve road connectivity in Bharatchandranagar block, a paver block road is being constructed from North Bharatchandranagar PWD road to West Paikhola High School under MGNREGA with the funds allotted in the previous financial year. The road is being constructed at the cost of 5 lakh 88 thousand 460 rupees. This was informed by Bharatchandranagar block office.

7,117 families benefited under CMSPY in Chandipur block

Different kinds of assistance has been provided to 7 thousand 117 beneficiary families under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in Chandipur block in the previous financial year. Among these families, 3 thousand 658 beneficiary families were provided with 15 tree saplings each of Areca nut, papaya, lemon etc., along with 50 grams of vegetable seeds. Apart from that, 709 beneficiary families of the block have been given 500 mixed fish fingerlings under the scheme. 2 thousand 750 beneficiary families were given five different kinds of 1saplings of cash crops.

Sewing machines distributed to 60 women in Bishalgarh

Sewing machines have been provided to 60 women in Bishalgarh block by utilising Sepahijala Zilla Parishad Panchayat Development Fund. These sewing machines have been given to 36 persons belonging to SC community and 24 sewing machines have been given to other women. As a result, the total expenditure of the Panchayat Development Fund was 2 lakh 10 thousand 700 rupees.

Assistance to 3,736 beneficiaries in Bishalgarh under PMMVY

Assistance has been provided to 3 thousand 736 pregnant ladies under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana in Bishalgarh sub-division. Among these pregnant women, 1 thousand 222 from Charilam block, 2 thousand 178 from Bishalgarh block and 336 pregnant women from Bishalgarh Municipal Council area are getting the benefits under the scheme. It is to be noted that the beneficiaries are being provided with 1 financial assistance of 5 thousand rupees in three instalments under the scheme.

Administrative camp to be held in Jampuijala block on June 8,9

Two administrative camps will be organized in two different places of Jampuijala block on June 8 and 9. The first camp will be organized in the premises of Kendraichara High School in Kendraichara ADC village of Jampuijala block. The other camp will be organized in the premises of Gangthakur Para Bazar in Pekuyarjala ADC village. Applications will be taken for Aadhaar card, PRTC, income certificate, birth and death certificate, ST/SC and marriage certificate in the camp. Free medicines will be distributed to the locals with the initiative of the Health department after conducting health

check-ups in the camp. A review meeting will also be conducted on different development works of the concerned areas in the sub-division with the officials of various departments in both the camps. Jampuijala SDM Sanjit Debbarma urged the locals of the concerned areas to take advantage of these camps.

1,225.44 MT of paddy procured at MSP in Sonamura

1,225.44 MT of paddy has been procured in previous Kharif season in Sonamura at Minimum Support Price. Each quintal of paddy was procured at 1,940 rupees. As a result, 617 farmers have benefited. 37 lakh 73 thousand 982 rupees has been sent to the bank accounts of the farmers.

6 deep tube wells installed under JJM in Tulashikhar block

Six deep tube wells have been installed in Tulashikhar block under Jal Jeevan Mission in the previous financial year. Apart from that, work is going on to install more 19 deep tube wells in the block. 60 lakh rupees will be spent in the installation of each deep tube well. 32 Deep tube wells in Khowai block under JJM

So far, 32 deep tube wells have been installed in Khowai block under Jal Jeevan Mission to create sources of clean drinking water. It is to be noted that

target was taken to install 46 deep tube wells in Khowai block in the last two years. At present, installation of 14 deep tube wells is under progress. Apart from that, free clean drinking water connections have been provided to 7 thousand 946 families of Khowai block under Jal Jeevan Mission so far. Paddy procurement at MSP to start on June 8 in Sonamura sub-division

The process of paddy procurement from the farmers at Minimum Support Price will start from June 8 in Sonamura sub-division. In the first phase, paddy will be procured from six areas of the sub-division at the rate of 1,940 rupees per quintal. The paddy will be procured from farmers at Jagannath Bari from June 8 till June 12, at Bairagi Bazar Nat Mandir from June 15 till June 20, at Sonamura Agri Market from June 24 till June 28, at the premises of Boxanagar Community Hall from June 30 till July 1, in the premises of Kathalia Community Hall from July 18 till July 24 and at Dhanpur New Motorstand from July 27 till July 31. Each farmer can sell minimum 3 quintals and maximum 50 quintals of paddy. This was informed by Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs department, Sonamura sub-division office.
