

Health Fair in 4 blocks of Unakoti district on April 18

Block-Level Health Fair will be conducted in 4 blocks of Unakoti district on April 18. A preparatory meeting was held yesterday for the successful conduction of the Block-Level Health Fair. The meeting was presided over by District Magistrate of Unakoti district Uttam Kumar Chakma. It was decided in the meeting that the Health Fair will be conducted at Chinibagan HS ground of Gouranagar block, Manu Valley HS ground of Chandipur block, Laljuri HS ground of Kumarghat block and Bagaichara School ground of Pechartal block.

Different departments including the health department will open 15 stalls at the event. Those present in the meeting were Sabhadhipati of Unakoti Zilla Parishad Amalendu Das, Sahakari Sabhadhipati Shyamal Das, Chairman of Chandipur Panchayat Samiti Lucky Pal Das, Pechartal BAC Chairman Sajal Chakma, Chandipur Block BDO L. Tochang and other officials of different departments.

Representatives of Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute visit Tripura

Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute campus is about to start functioning in the state. A representative team of Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute mentioned about the possibility of setting up Film Institute in a conference at the Secretariat after visiting Nazrul Kalakhetra campus yesterday. Information & Cultural department Minister Sushanta Choudhury, Director of the department Ratan Biswas, Director In-charge of Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute Samiran Dutta and other members and officials of PWD and ICA department were present during the conference.

Director In-charge of Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute informed, the space available in Nazrul Kalakhetra is enough for classroom, editing lab etc. And with the facilities available in the campus, it is possible to start short-term courses on Film Appreciation, Screen Acting and Documentary Making in a very short time. Among these courses, Film Appreciation course can be started as a basic course as the required space for classroom and a

screening hall is available for the course. He emphasized upon encouraging aspirant youth to take up the courses. He said, different long duration courses can be gradually started if the technical infrastructure is improved after starting these 3 short duration courses. Proposal has been sent to the state government for arranging different infrastructures such as shooting floor, sound proof room, lighting etc., to set up Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute in Tripura.

ICA Minister said, the state government is proceeding with a plan to set up a Film Industry in the state, even if it is possible in a limited form. Aspirant youth can take the training from different courses and use the experience in the state as well as outside the state and create their own job opportunities. He said, there are plenty of youth interested in acting and modelling. There is a scope for taking the Film Industry forward based on the scenic beauty and different religious spots of the state.

Director of ICA department Ratan Biswas asked Director In-charge of Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute to send an IT expert team to check on different

technical infrastructure improvement at Nazrul Kalakhetra campus for setting up of Satyajit Roy Film & Television Institute in the state.

Water reservoirs for rainwater harvesting in Kumarghat

With a view to increasing the level of ground water, water reservoirs to preserve rainwater will be created at five places of Kumarghat Municipal area. Water from these water reservoirs will be transported through pipeline inside the ground. Three water reservoirs will be created at Pabiachara HS School, Pabiachara Colony High School and Kumarghat HS Girls School at the cost of 28 lakh 71 thousand 985 rupees from the funds of 15th Finance Commission. Water reservoirs will also be created nearby Fatikroy bridge and nearby North Kumarghat Petrol Pump at the cost of 19 lakh 11 thousand 846 rupees. Tendering process has recently finished for this. Work order will be issued within few days. On the other side, construction of public toilets under Swachha Bharat Mission at Vivekananda Chowmuni in Kumarghat has been completed at the cost of 8 lakh 91

thousand 642 rupees. This was informed by Kumarghat Municipal office.

Pucca houses to 33 families in Srikantabari ADC Village under PMAY-G

Pucca houses are being constructed for 33 beneficiary families under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin in the previous financial year in Srikantabari ADC Village of Jolaibari block. Each Pucca house is being built at the cost of 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees. Besides this, 75 development works such as land levelling, water irrigation source creation and road repairing have been implemented in the village under MGNREGA. Total 66 lakh 59 thousand 344 rupees was spent for this and 34 thousand 710 mandays was generated. This was informed by Srikantabari ADC Village office.

Assistance for Dragon fruit cultivation in Bishargarh

Under Mission for Integrated Development and Horticulture, assistances for Dragon fruit cultivation are being provided in Bishalgarh agricultural sub-division. Through this, a beneficiary of Raghunathpur Gram Panchayat and a beneficiary of Madhupur Gram Panchayat

of Bishalgarh block, beneficiary of Amtali village of Charilam block have benefitted. 5 Ha land of the agricultural sub-division has been brought under Dragon fruit cultivation through this. 1 lakh 87 thousand 500 rupees was spent for this. This was informed by Supervisor of Horticulture & Soil Conservation department, Bishalgarh sub-division office Priyatosh Sarkar.

Assistance for Khaki Campbell duck breeding under CMSPY

Assistance for Khaki Campbell duck breeding has been given to 37 beneficiary families of Bishalgarh block under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana at the office premises of Assistant Director of Animal Resources Development Department in Bishalgarh. Each beneficiary family of the block was given 10 Khaki Campbell ducklings, 2 kilograms of duck feed and a cage by Chairperson of Bishalgarh Panchayat Samiti Chanda Debbarma and Assistant Director of ARDD Dr. Mousumi Das. Chairperson of Bishalgarh Panchayat Samiti on the occasion said, the government has prioritized helping people of the rural areas to become self-dependent through CMSPY.
