

Water connection to 4,041 families of Dumburnagar block under Atal Jaldhara Mission

Initiative will be taken by Drinking Water & Sanitation department to provide free water connection to 4 thousand 41 families of Dumburnagar block area in Dhalai district in the present financial year under Atal Jaldhara Mission. This was informed by executive engineer Hiranmay Chakma, DWS, Ambassa division. In 2020-21 financial year, 2 thousand 799 families of this block were given free water connection.

CM inaugurates new building of Tulashikhar PHC & Chebri PHC

“Government is working for the overall development of the state. Government is also giving importance to employment generation besides health safety of the citizens of the state even amidst Covid pandemic. Development in education, health, power, drinking water and infrastructure sector through different schemes is governments priority,” said the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after laying foundation stone of new building of Chebri primary health centre and inaugurating new building of Tulashikhar primary health centre in Khowai district yesterday. After laying foundation stone

of new building of Chebri primary health centre, chief minister urged for everyone’s active participation in Covid vaccination with positive attitude. He also felicitated four persons for donating land for building the new building of the health centre. After inauguration of new building of Tulashikhar primary health centre, he handed over Ayushman Bharat e-card to three beneficiaries.

Chief minister in both programmes said that Tripura is leading in Covid vaccination in the country. The state has achieved 91% Covid vaccination, however Tulashikhar area has been lagging behind to some extent in this case. He said, “Protecting our health should be our first priority. A group of people who have spread false rumour about Covid vaccination are taking vaccines now. The initiative to achieve 100% Covid vaccination in the state has been taken for health safety of its citizen with the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi.” He urged the locals of Tulashikhar area to actively participate in taking Covid vaccination. He also emphasized the need for more public awareness on different state and central schemes available for the welfare of people.

Tribal welfare minister Mevar Kumar Jamatia in the inaugural programme of

new building of Tulashikhar primary health centre said, government prioritizes improvement in quality of living of the people of the state. If health is deteriorated, work cannot be performed well which is why tribal welfare minister emphasized taking Covid vaccine. Different developmental works are being implemented even amidst Covid pandemic. Recently, 156 doctors were recruited all at once for strengthening health services. Apart from this, government is giving importance to health infrastructure across the state, he said.
