The central and state government has taken various initiatives for the development of human resource. The state government has taken initiative to reach out with health care facilities to the people of remote areas, stated the Union minister for social justice and empowerment Pratima Bhowmik yesterday while addressing the gathering as the chief guest of a mega health camp at Toibandal Higher Secondary School. Taking part in the discussion there she said, initiative has been taken to decentralize the health services in the state. Towards this oxygen plants are being set up in district and sub-divisional hospitals.

Among others present in the health camp were chairman of Mohanbhog BAC Basalya Noatia, MDC Padmalochan Tripura, and chairman of Mohanbhog Panchayat Samiti Sribas Bhowmik. Welcome address was given by the

general secretary of All Tripura Doctors' Association Dr. Shankar Chakraborty. Pediatrician, gynaecologist, orthopedist, ENT specialist and other doctors attended to the health needs of the local people in the camp. In the camp a total of 650 people received free diagnosis and medicines.

Meeting in connection with registration on e-Shram portal

A meeting in connection with registration of unorganized workers on the e-Shram portal was held at the conference hall of Sepahijala Zilla Parishad yesterday. Additional DM Subhasis Bandhopadhyay presided over the meeting while the officials of labour department and district administration also attended the meeting.

In the meeting an official of labour department informed, names of unorganized workers will be registered on the e-Shram portal. Construction workers, vendors, drivers, agricultural labourers, members of SHG, maid servant, ASHA workers, Anganwadi workers, footpath vendors, rickshaw pullers, workers of brick kilns, daily wagers, MGNREGA labourers, fish farmers, and small shopkeepers may have the facility to register their names on the portal. They will be brought under Pradhan Mantri Safety Insurance Yojana. In case of death the family of any worker of unorganized

sector will get the benefit. The insurance scheme will also cover accidents. The additional DM said, to create awareness about the scheme special camps will be started at block and Gram Panchayat level towards the end of October.
