

Door-to-door health care facility for elderly started

Under the National Health Mission's NPHCE project all kinds of health care facilities are being provided to the elderly persons from every government health centre. To ensure health protection for the 'silver population' of our society one day in a week has been earmarked for them. Under the project community health officer, MPW, ASHA etc. health workers of South Hichachera health sub-centre in Ramraibari of South district yesterday went door to door to carry out health check up for the aged people. Blood pressure, blood sugar etc. were checked and necessary medicines were given to them free of cost. This initiative has been taken to facilitate health service in COVID-19 situation. These kinds of facilities are being given to the 60 plus people from the district and state level hospitals. This was divulged in a press release from the health and family welfare department.

45-Day training for women handloom artisans of Dukli

A training programme for women handloom artisans of Chowmuhani Bazar gram panchayat of Dukli block had started on December 7. Sabhadhipati of West

Tripura Zilla Parishad Antara Sarkar (Deb) inaugurated the 45-day training programme at Durgapur High School. This training programme has been organized by Agartala Weavers Service Centre of Skill India Commission, Agartala, under the Government of India's Skill Development Training and Handloom Weaving. A total of 21 women artisans are taking part in this training.

E-cards distribution in Bishalgarh sub-division under Ayushman Bharat

A special meeting was held on 7th December under Ayushman Bharat-PMJAY scheme in Bishalgarh sub-division in Sepahijala district where the beneficiaries were distributed e-cards. Apart from 30 MPW and 3 MPS, District Program Co-ordinator (PMJAY) DME, DAPM etc were present in the meeting. State Health and Family Welfare Association's Member Secretary has informed this in a press release.

Power tillers distributed among farmers in West Tripura

Initiative has been taken by the West District horticulture and soil conservation office to give 25 power tillers to the farmers of different blocks of the West District at subsidised rate in the current

fiscal year. Farmers will be given 75 thousand rupees subsidy under MIDH scheme for each power tiller. Recently, 15 farmers got power tillers. Among them three farmers were from Dukli block, 10 farmers were from Mandai block, two farmers were from Hezamara block who got power tillers. Power tiller will be given to at least two farmers from Mohanpur, Lefunga, Bamutia, Jirania and Old Agartala block. West District office of the horticulture and soil conservation department has informed this.

Water connections under Atal Jaldhara Mission

Drinking water connections have been given to total 8,454 families of 7 blocks in Sepahijala district in the current fiscal year under Atal Jaldhara Mission. Recently, drinking water connections were given to 1,403 families of Bishalgarh block, to 1,379 families of Boxanagar block, to 1,153 families of Charilam block, to 1,431 families of Jampuijala block, to 1,545 families of Kathalia block, to 470 families of Mohanbhog block and to 1,073 families of Nalchar block. Drinking water and sanitation department's Bishalgarh division office has informed this.

Brick soling in Kanpui village

Brick soling is being done on three roads under MGNREGA to develop the

communication system in Kanpui ADC village of Jampui Hill block under the aegis of rural development department in the current fiscal year spending 44 lakh 38 thousand 374 rupees. Recently, brick soling was completed on 628 m road from PWD road to Budhamandir in the village spending 13 lakh 84 thousand 829 rupees. Apart from this, brick soling on 260 m road from M.C Rai Reangbari to PWD road in the village was completed spending 5 lakh 54 thousand 431 rupees. Brick soling work is being done on 1km 179.5 m road from Twikrai S.B School to Twikrai Para in the village spending 24 lakh 99 thousand 114 rupees. Kanchanpur R.D division office has informed this.

Solar power plants installed in Dhalai district

Ten solar power plants have been set up in different aspirational block areas in Dhalai district. Under this project, three plants in Dumboor Nagar block, three in Raishabari block and four in Chawmanu block have been set up. Apart from this, five solar pumps in PTG villages in each block i.e, total 10 solar pumps were installed in Dumboor Nagar and Ganganagar blocks respectively. This project was implemented under the initiative of science, technology and environment department and with the help of Tripura Renewable Energy Development Agency.
