

Agri-equipments distributed among SHGs in Jampuijala

Under the aegis of agriculture department agricultural equipments were distributed SHGs among two of Jampuijala subdivision vesterday through а programme held at Gabardi community hall premises. MLA Birendra Kishore Debbarma handed over the agricultural equipments to the members of SHGs. The equipments included power tiller, spray paddy harvester, irrigation machine, pump set etc. To implement this under SMAM scheme an amount of Rs. 9.50 lakh has been spent for each SHG. The SGHs had to deposit only Rs. 50,000, i.e. they have availed a subsidy of Rs. 9 lakh. Paharni Lakhma and Baarkha are the two SHGs that have benefited from this. The agriculture supervisor Kisngshuk Debbarma informed that the equipments have been procured under SMAM scheme during the 2019-20 financial year.

Review on development activities in Kakraban block

A review meeting on the progress of all development activities in Kakraban block was held at the conference hall of Kakraban Panchayat Samiti on June 9, 2020. M.P Pratima Bhowmik emphasized

in the review meeting on socio-economic development of people of the block. She advised the concerned to finish different schemes including MGNREGA within stipulated time. She said that sources of drinking water have to be active. No cultivable land should be left uncultivated due to lack of irrigation facility. Moreover, In the beginning of the review meeting, BDO of Kakraban block Abhijit Das has informed that 78,300 mandays under MGNREGA have been generated. 10,508 families have benefited under the scheme. Till now, construction of 49 houses out of 119 houses under PM Awas Yojana sanctioned during the last financial year has been completed till now.

Moreover, discussion was done on various schemes of DWS, power, agriculture, horticulture, irrigation, PWD(WR), ARD, PWD, health, fishery, forest etc. departments. MLA Biplab Kumar Ghosh, chairman of Kakraban Panchavat Samiti Supriya Saha, vice-chairman Sudhir Majumder, chairman of BAC Upendra Jamatia , Debal Debroy, social activist Abhishek Debroy, Jitendra Majumder, SDM of Udaipur subdivision Aniruddha Roy and the officers of different departments were present in the review meeting.

Advance preparatory meeting held at Kailashahar to prevent flood

A preparatory meeting was held with different clubs and representatives of NGOs of the subdivision at the conference hall of the office of SDM, Kailashahar on June 8, 2020 to prevent flood. Additional SDM Jogesh Reang and deputy CEO of Kailashahar MC Tapas Kumar Singha were present in the meeting. The delegates discussed in the meeting on actions to be taken in flood situation.

It was informed that a team of 40 SDRF members of is staying at Kailashahar. They will provide gaosabhabased training to the volunteers. 172 shelter houses were opened in the subdivision 2018. in Necessary arrangement will be made for combating Covid-19 in each shelter house. Provision of drinking water, power and necessary medicines for water borne diseases will be confirmed in the shelters. 69 boats, 3 speed boats and 4 motor-less government rubber boats are available in the subdivision.

Decision has been taken that administration will take initiative to make some wooden boats. Advance arrangement will be made on behalf of the administration for providing mask to the affected persons in the shelter houses. A control room will be opened at the office of SDM.
