

Training on Bio-floc fish culture started

A five-day training on bio-floc fish culture was organized in on November 9. This North Tripura district level training camp was inaugurated by the deputy speaker of Tripura Legislative Assembly Biswabandhu Sen. However, the first segment of the camp was organized by the fishery department at the conference hall of North Tripura district fishery office. The camp will continue up to November 13, 2020.

Sabhadhipati of North Tripura Zilla Parishad Bhabatosh Das was present in the programme as chief guest. The programme was presided over by member of Dharmanagar Municipal Council Nabanita Acharjee. 10 People of the district participated in the camp. The guests and officials discussed various aspects of the training after its inauguration.

House allotted for 11 Reang families in Santirbazar

House is being constructed by TRP & PTG department for 11 BPL Reang families of Shantirbazar subdivision under PM Awas Yojana. Rs 2 lakh 126 thousand will be spent for construction of each house under the scheme. Total 23 lakh 76 thousand

rupees will be spent for this purpose. The programme officer of Baikhora TR Range in South district under TRP & PTG department has informed this.

Providing clean drinking water to each family of the state is one of the main priorities for the Government: CM

Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb today chaired the first conference of the Tripura Jal Board in hall no.1 at the Secretariat. To strengthen the drinking water supply system in the city and drainage system Tripura Jal Board consisting of nine members was formed based on the Tripura Jal Board Act,2020. The chairman of the board is the Minister of Urban Development Department and Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb and the vice-chairman is the Secretary, Urban Development. Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb in the conference said, 'Providing clean drinking water to each family of the state is one of the main priorities for the government. The Government is working with a specific plan for this purpose.' He expressed hope that this work will be accelerated even more with the formation of the Tripura Jal Board.

Kiran Gitte, Secretary, Urban Development putting up various aspects of The Tripura Jal Board Act,2020 said, 'Tripura Jal Board Fund will be created for

the management of Tripura Jal Board. A general board meeting will be held once in every three months. In every five years the property of the Board will be evaluated'. He also said that Tripura Jal Board will play a significant role to strengthen and bring efficiency in the drinking water supply system in the city and drainage system and briefly discussed about the functions of the Board. He added, 'At present 186 deep tube well and 1517.49 km pipeline connection has been provided in 20 municipal areas; big and small water treatment plants are there in most urban areas.' A MoU agreement was discussed to be signed by the Chief Minister and Tripura Jal Board in the conference about the property, staff and grants for five years. Decision was taken in the conference to commence the work of Tripura Jal Board full fledged from the 1st of April next year.

2553 families of Hejamara block benefited under PM Matru Vandana Yojana

2553 pregnant women of 23 ADC villages in Hezamara block have been covered by Hezamara ICDS project of the social welfare and social education department under PM Matru Vandana Yojana. Rs 5000 as financial assistance has been provided to selected beneficiaries in three installments. This financial assistance has

been provided to 1042 persons in 1st installment, 894 persons in second installment and 617 persons in third installment. CDPO of Hezamara ICDS project Niva Debbarma has informed this.

30 families of Twisama village benefit under PMAY

Pakka houses have been constructed in several areas of different Panchayats of Dasda block.
