

Khowai district's small savings target Rs. 39 crore

Target has been set to collect Rs. 39 crore during the current financial year in Khowai district under Small Savings Scheme. Till November an amount of Rs. 24.69 crore has been collected in the district, informed the small savings development officer. He said, for Teliamura subdivision target was fixed at Rs. 25 crore and in practice Rs. 14.94 crore. For Khowai target was Rs. 14 crore and already Rs. 9.75 crore has been collected.

Awareness camp on malaria held at 43 Mile

Under the aegis of Teliamura sub-divisional hospital in Khowai district a malaria identification camp was organized at Nonachera sub-health centre on December 5. Apart from discussion on malaria, other infectious diseases were also discussed in the camp. Total 26 patients had availed health care facility including medicines. Not only how to prevent and eradicate malaria was discussed, but use of mosquito net, prevention of multiplication of mosquito population, symptoms of malaria etc. were discussed. To spread awareness further, music and street drama presentation were resorted to. In a press release the secretary of State Health and Family Welfare Committee has informed this.
