

Laptops distributed among 39 teachers in Dharmanagar

As part of Pradhan Mantri Digital Bharat scheme laptops were distributed by the education department among 39 teachers at BBI School, Dharmanagar recently. Deputy speaker of Tripura Legislative Assembly, Biswabandhu Sen was present in the programme as chief guest. He handed over the laptops to the beneficiaries.

Applications being received for social pensions in Teliamura

The process of taking application for different social security pension schemes has started at the conference hall of Teliamura Panchayat on October 9. The chief whip of Tripura Legislative Assembly Kalyani Roy ceremonially opened the process. The programme was presided over by the chairman of Panchayat Samiti Jamuna Das Roy. The chief whip, in her speech, informed that social security pension would be given to 30,000 new applicants. CDPO Sanjoy Dey discussed different aspects of social security pension schemes while BDO Santanu Bikash Das delivered welcome address.

Initiative for revival of tea industry in Mayachhari

Different measures have been taken to revive the tea industry in Mayachhari Panchayat in Durgachowmuhani Block. As a part of this initiative, pesticide and spray machines have been distributed among the tea growers of the panchayat through a formal programme on October 8. The distribution programme was held at Jagannath Nat Mandir in the panchayat. Chairperson of Durgachowmuhani Panchayat Samiti Sampa Das, vice-chairman Tapas Paul, upa-Pradhan of the panchayat Sabyasachi Goala were present in the programme. Saraswati Debnath, Pradhan of the panchayat presided over the programme. A total of 35 beneficiaries received spray machines and pesticide. On the other hand, recently 5000 tea saplings were provided to each of 270 tea growers of Mayachhari Panchayat for tea plantation in 2.5 kani land each family.

Assistance for animal rearing in Jampuijala block

An initiative has been taken by the animal resources development department for animal rearing in Jampuihill block of Kanchanpur subdivision under Rastriya Krishi Vikash Yojana during the last financial year. Six piglets and feed were

given to each of four beneficiaries of Jampuihill block under the scheme. Rs 97,000 has been spent for each beneficiary under the scheme. Moreover, 30 chicks have been provided to each of 30 beneficiaries of Jampuihill block under RKBY. Rs 5000 has been spent for each beneficiary. Kanchanpur subdivision animal resources development office has informed this.

13 Deep tube wells in offing in Laljuri & Jampuihill blocks

An initiative has been taken by DWS department for expansion of pure drinking water supply system in Laljuri and Jampuihill blocks of Kanchanpur subdivision during the current year. An initiative has been taken for installation of 13 deep tube wells in Laljuri and Jampuihill blocks under the scheme during current year. Recently installation of one deep tube well at Malakar Basti and one deep tube well at Kamalghat of Mukumchhara village in Laljuri block have been completed.

Awareness camp on Social Security Pension in Sabroom

An awareness camp on social security pension was organized by Sabroom CDPO office at conference hall of Sabroom Nagar Panchayat on October 8, 2020.

Chairperson of Sabroom Nagar Panchayat Ruma Majumdar Basak, Vice-chairperson of Sabroom Nagar Panchayat Mahitosh Chakraborty and CDPO Subash Debnath were present in the programme. The members of 9 wards of Nagar Panchayat were also present there. Discussion on providing social pensions declared by the state government to new 30,000 beneficiaries was held in the programme. It is mentioned that distribution and reception of applications for providing social pension has started from October 1, 2020.

Distribution of 15 MT high yielding paddy seeds in Killa

15 MT high yielding paddy seeds have been distributed by the agriculture and farmers' welfare department among the farmers under Killa agri-subdivision. Total 1386 hectare land of the agri-subdivision has been covered under *aman* cultivation. Beside this, high breed paddy has been cultivated in 267 hectare land. Moreover, corn in 300 hectare land, Maskalai in 1000 hectare land, ground nut in 12 hectare land, sesame in 75 hectare land and Arhar in 50 hectare land have been cultivated.
