

MoS for culture assures all possible help for development of culture



The chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb has requested the minister of state for culture Arjun Ram Meghwal for a holistic decision on the proposal of the state government to build a Cultural Hub during a courtesy meeting at the state secretariat today. During the meeting detailed discussion was held on culture, history, heritage and tradition. The chief minister informed the minister of state for culture that the proposed Cultural Hub worth Rs. 200 crore has been conceptualized to develop the culture of not only Tripura but also the entire Northeast region. With the implementation of the project both culture and tourism of Tripura will be developed.

Speaking on the multi-pronged development prospects of Tripura the chief minister said, construction of international airport in Agartala is nearing

completion. Chittagong port is also not very far. Tripura is the most peaceful state in the Northeast, added the chief minister. Shedding light on the tourism prospects of the state he further said, Neermahal, Tripura Sundari Temple, Unakoti, Chhabimura have immense tourism prospects and necessary infrastructure is being developed.

On the other hand, expressing satisfaction on the multi-pronged development of culture of Tripura and assured his all possible assistance in this regard. The chief minister handed over a bamboo art piece and a book written on the life Maharaja Bir Bikram Manikya Bahadur to the minister of state for culture. During this courtesy meeting secretary of ICA department P.K. Goyal was also present. Later on while talking to the media he said, he would take up the matter of Cultural Hub with the ministry of finance and NITI Aayog.

Power connection in Manu and Chawmanu block

Initiative has been taken to provide free of cost power connection to 12,864 families in Manu and Chawmanu block areas of Longtharai Valley sub division under Saubhagya Yojana in 2018-19 financial year. So far 8,060 families have

been provided power connection. Target has been set to provide power connection to 7,395 families under this scheme in Manu block area. So far 5,254 families were given power connection. On the other hand, target has been set to provide power connection to 5,459 families, so far 2,806 families were provided power connection. This was informed by DGM Shyamal Baidya, Dhalai district, TSECL. He further said that under this scheme, target has been set to provide 21.9 km HT line and 105 km Lt line extension in Manu block area, so far 19 km HT line and 101 km LT line extension was given. Apart from this, under this scheme, target has been set to provide 6.3 km HT line and 60 km LT line extension to Chawmanu block area, so far 0.36 km HT line and 26 km LT line extension was given.

Social pension in Dhalai district

39,542 beneficiaries are getting different kinds of central and state social pension in Dhalai district. This was informed by deputy director Uttam Kumar, Social Welfare and Social Education department, Dhalai district. He said that the beneficiaries were given pensions of May, June and July in June month to their accounts. He also said that 6,347 beneficiaries under Ambassa project, 16,747 beneficiaries under Salema project, 1,052 beneficiaries under

Kamalpur Nagar Panchayat project, 7,070 under Manu project, 4,498 under Dumboor Nagar project and 3,828 under Chawmanu project are getting various social pensions.

Paddy procurement in Bharatchandra Nagar block

Paddy procurement from 294 farmers at MSP Rs. 18.68 paisa was held at Lakhipur Agri Store Complex in Bharatchandra Nagar block from 3rd July to 10th July with the initiative of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs department and with the assistance of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare department. 4 lakh 89 thousand 697 kilograms of paddy was procured. This was informed by Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs department, Belonia sub division.

Toilet construction in Ranirkhamar market

Toilets are being constructed under Swaccha Bharat Mission at Ranirkhamar Market which falls under Madhuban Gram Panchayat of Dukli block investing total 3 lakh rupees in the present financial year. Apart from this, in 2020-21 financial year toilets were constructed for 691 beneficiaries in the block area under Swachha Bharat Mission investing total 82 lakh 92 rupees. This was informed by Dukli block office.
