

Drinking water connections in Mohanpur under AJM

Under the initiative of Drinking water & Sanitation department, free drinking water connection is being given to every house in different Gram Panchayat and ADC villages of Mohanpur, Bamutia, Lefunga block under Atal Jaldhara Mission. So far in the current financial year, 938 houses of Bamutia block, 900 houses of Mohanpur block and 264 houses of Lefunga block have been given drinking water connection. This information was collected from Mohanpur Drinking water & Sanitation office.

Power tiller under Mission for Integrated Development in Horticulture

With the initiative of West district Horticulture & Soil Conservation department under MIDH scheme in the present financial year, 30 families of West district were given power tillers at subsidized rate, 21 families were provided with vermi-compost tanks and 5 families were given mobile vending cards. Among those families, 11 families of Mohanpur sub division were given power tiller, 3 families were given mobile vending cards and 1 vermi-compost tank was built for 1

family. 4 families of Jirania agricultural sub division were given power tiller, 2 families were given mobile vending cards and vermi-compost tanks were built for 7 families. 3 families were given power tiller, 2 families of Dukli agricultural sub division were given power tillers, vermi-compost tanks were built for 5 families. 10 families of Mandwi agricultural sub division were given power tillers, vermi-compost tanks were built for 4 families. CM inaugurates newly built Sabroom sub division hospital building



Plans of about 80 crore rupees have been taken up for developing Sabroom city. It is because of Prime Minister Narendra Modi that Sabroom residents are reaping the benefits of the development works carried out across the state, enunciated Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating the newly built 100-bedded Sabroom sub division hospital building

and oxygen plant yesterday. Around 13.5 crore rupees was invested in building this sub divisional hospital. Chief Minister and Minister of States for Health and Family Welfare Dr. Bharti Pravin Pawar paid homage to the statue of Mother Teresa at the hospital with flowers. They also handed sewing machines to 34 women SHG members who have already received training on sewing and handed bicycles to 25 women. Apart from this, wheelchairs to 2 Divyangans and Ayushman Bharat card to 2 beneficiaries were handed over on behalf of the health department. Chief Minister and other guests on this day visited various sections of the hospital. Minister of States for Health and Family Welfare Dr. Bharti Pravin Pawar after her visit expressed her satisfaction with overall management of the hospital.

Chief Minister said, for a long period of time Sabroom residents have been neglected in various aspects of development. There was shortage in providing various facilities. Plans of about 80 crore rupees were taken up for modernisation and overall development of Sabroom city. Works are in progress to bring socio-economic as well as overall development of Sabroom residents. Apart from that, Special Economic Zone, Maitri Setu built over River Feni to develop Indo-Bangla trade, Sabroom Integrated Checkpost are all adding up to the

economic development of the state. As a result, Sabroom as well as the whole state will witness economic development. Government is working giving utmost priority to developing the health services. He hoped this sub division hospital will play an important role in providing modern health services to the residents of the sub division. He further said, besides bringing development in health infrastructure, in just 39 days MBBS doctors were recruited through transparent policy. Initially a specialist will be appointed along with other doctors in this hospital. He also said that there are further plans to provide more doctors to Sabroom in future.

Others present in the programme were MLA Sankar Roy, Principal Secretary of Health JK Sinha, Director of Health Subhasish Debbarma, DM, South Tripura Saju Wahid A, and Chairman of South Tripura Zilla Parishad Kakali Das Dutta.

Assistance to 25,000 families of west district under CMSPY

Work is under progress to distribute 4 lemon saplings each to 25 thousand 405 families of 9 blocks of West district under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana with the initiative of Horticulture & Soil Conservation department. So far 23 thousand 830 families have been given

lemon saplings. Among them 2859 families are from Mohanpur block, 2671 from Bamutia block, 2986 from Lefunga block, 2411 from Jirania block, 1550 from Old Agartala block, 2894 from Belbari block, 2626 from Dukli block, 2873 from Hezamara block, 2960 from Mandwi block. 40 Ponds excavated in Padmabil under MGNREGA

In the previous financial year, 40 ponds were excavated in different ADC villages of Padmabil block area under MGNREGA on tribal beneficiary land. Three ponds were excavated in Akhrabari village, 2 in South Ramchandraghat village, 3 in Gayamani village, 1 in Jalai Twisa village, 6 in Paglabari ADC village, 3 in West Belchara village, 2 in East Belchara village, 4 in Rasaraj nagar village, 2 in Ratanpur village, 8 in Twihasingbari village, 3 in Upendra nagar village, 3 in North Padmabil village. All ponds were excavated spending 1 crore 19 lakh 4 thousand 915 rupees. This information was collected from Padmabil block office.

Assistance to beneficiaries under Mukhyamantri Unnat Godhan Prakalp

590 Beneficiaries were given assistance under Mukhyamantri Unnat Godhan

Prakalp with the initiative of Amarpur ARDD. Apart from that, from previous financial year's fund, 40 beneficiaries of Amarpur & Silachari block areas were given piglets under National Livestock Mission. Each beneficiary was given 3 piglets spending 21 thousand rupees per beneficiary. Under the same scheme, 40 beneficiaries of Karbook block were given 5 goat cubs each spending 66 thousand per beneficiary. 140 Solar street lights in Kailasahar

140 Solar street lights were installed in Kailasahar sub division through Tripura Renewable Energy Development Agency under Renewable Energy ministry scheme. Among them, 80 solar street lights were installed in Chandipur block, 60 in Gournagar block. 22 thousand 600 rupees was invested in installing each street light. Total 31 lakh 64 thousand rupees was invested in installing 140 solar streetlights in the sub division.

Eight new brick soling roads in Tulashikhar block under MGNREGA

Eight new brick soling roads were constructed till July in the present financial year in Tulashikhar block area. Total length of roads is 3km 545 m. Total investment was 58 lakh 24 thousand 721

rupees. 783m brick road was laid in Bidyabil ADC village of the block area, 915 brick road was laid in West Behalabari ADC block village, 174m in Tokchayabari ADC village, 625m in Badlabari ADC village, 390m Twichingrambari ADC village, 358m in Sikaribari ADC village, 243m in Radhacharan nagar ADC village and 57m in Rajnagar ADC village. Assistance to 10 villages for animal rearing in Jampuijala block

Different types of assistance are being given to 10 villages of Jampuijala block under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana by ARD department. It was informed by the Joint director's office at Bishalgarh that 33 families in Pekuarjala village, 38 in Jampuijala village and 11 families in Dayaram para village were given 10 chicks, 2 kg chick feed and other materials each family. Joint director's office informed that in present financial year 10 villages will be given assistance and 11 villages will be given assistance in the next financial year.

1592 Families in Amarpur to be benefited under CMSPY

Initiatives have been taken by the ARDD to implement various works in Amarpur,

Ampi, Silachari and Karbook block area under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in the present financial year. Beneficiaries will be distributed chicks, piglets, goat cubs and ducklings. As a result, 1 thousand 592 families will be benefited. 198 beneficiary families of each block will be given 1 piglet each, 50 beneficiary families will be given 1 goat cub each and 50 families will be given 10 ducklings each. This information was collected from Amarpur ARDD office.

Assistance for tobacco & mushroom cultivation in West district

Assistance is being given to 4 families for tobacco cultivation and 2 families for mushroom cultivation in West Tripura district under special central scheme with the initiative of Horticulture and Soil Conservation department. 0.2 Ha tobacco garden has been raised for each of 2 tribal families of Hezamara block in the district spending 3 lakh 82 thousand 520 rupees. Apart from this, 0.2 Ha tobacco garden is being raised for each of 2 tribal families of Lefunga block. 2 SC category families of Jirania block will be given assistance for mushroom cultivation.
