

Foundation stone laid for TUDA project in Agartala

The township scheme of the Tripura Urban Planning and Development Authority (TUDA) will be considered a milestone in the development of the state, said the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after laying the foundation stone for the said scheme at Kaman Chowmuhani, Agartala. He said, urban planning organisations are operational in cities like Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai, but Tripura had none. After the new government took over it had started working towards urban planning. TUDA has been set up with this objective in view.

Apart from this, the chief minister said, the government would build 1000 flats for the poor under the centrally sponsored scheme Light House. Under the TUDA project 48 flats would be constructed in Vivekananda Market stall area of Kaman Chowmuhani of Agartala. Similarly, 216 flats will be constructed in Kunjaban area. By December, 2022, these flats are completed. These flats will have modern parking, gymnasium, community centre, CC TV camers, playground etc. facilities.

The programme was also attended by the Mayor of Agartala Municipal Corporation Dr. Prafullajit Sinha, councilor of AMC Ratna Datta, secretary of urban development department Kiran Gitte, and commissioner of TUDA Dr. Shailesh Kumar Yadav. On this occasion home loan approval letters were handed over to four customers of the Vivekananda Market area and Kinjaban area flats from SBI and Punjab National Bank. The chief minister handed over the loan approval letters.
