

So far 6,17,195 families received financial benefit under CM COVID Special Package

The process of providing financial assistance amounting Rs. 1000 for each family under Chief Minister COVID Special Relief Package has started. Under the scheme the food, civil supplies, and consumer affairs department is depositing Rs. 1000 directly into the bank accounts of beneficiary families. This AADHAAR based DBT has been started on June 1. The food, civil supplies and consumers affairs department has informed that initiative has been taken to deposit the said amount into the accounts of 6,30,082 Antyoday, Priority Household and identified APL families. So far an amount of Rs. 61,71,95,000 has been transferred to the accounts of 6,17,195 families. Families who have not yet received the amount have been asked to contact the food section in the SDM office with their ration card and bank passbook.

Relief kit distribution under CM COVID Special Package started

Distribution of relief packages has been started in Amarpur subdivision today. The programme at the Laipada JB School was inaugurated by MLA Ranjit Das, in the presence of SDM Bijoy Sinha and BDO

Richard Jongte. The relief kit distributed there consisted of 1 litre edible oil, 1 kg. salt, 2 kg. masoor dal, 100 cumin powder, 250 gm. Turmeric powder and 500 gm. Soyabean. Under the scheme today relief was also distributed in Bhumachera, Kartikpara, Tolarampara, Uttar Chelangang, Samatalpara, Padahampara, Rajak para, Sanakpara and Khedarnal market.

Similarly relief kit distribution was started in Khowai Municipal Council area from the ration shop of Ward NO. 9 today. Under the Ward No. 9 ration shop there are 271 families of beneficiaries. On the other hand, distribution of relief packages has been started in Dharmanagar subdivision on June 12 at the Dharmanagar BBI ground. In presence of the deputy speaker of Tripura Legislative Assembly Biswabandhu Sen, the dignitaries including the SDM Kamalesh Dhar handed over relief kits. A total of 36,744 families will benefit under the scheme in Dharmanagar subdivision.

4,666 persons receive Pension under Hezamara ICDS Project

4 thousand 666 persons of Hezamara block area have received different pensions of the central and state government under Hezamara ICDS project. Among them, 2 thousand 666 persons are getting pension from 3 pension schemes of central government and 2 thousand 111 persons are getting pension from 23 pension schemes of state government. Assistance for Areca nut cultivation in Khowai district

In the present fiscal year, assistance will be given to 46 tribal farmers of Khowai

district for Areca nut cultivation to make them financially self reliant. 0.2 Ha for each beneficiary and total 9.20 Ha land of the district will be brought under Areca nut cultivation. That is 3.06 Ha in Tulashikhor agricultural sub division, 3.06 Ha in Padmabil agricultural sub division and 3.08 Ha in Teliamura agricultural sub division will be brought under Areca nut cultivation. Total amount of 17 lakh 59 thousand 592 rupees will be spent on this. This was informed by the deputy director of horticulture and soil conservation, Khowai district.
