

Drinking water connections in Killa & Kakraban under Atal Jaldhara

Drinking water connections have been provided to 172 families of Killa and Kakraban blocks free of cost under Atal Jaldhara Mission during the current financial year till now. Drinking water connections have been provided to 76 families of Killa block and 96 families of Kakraban block. Under the scheme, drinking water connections had been provided to 480 families of Killa block and 565 families of Kakraban block during the last financial year. The DWS office of the executive engineer, Udaipur has informed this.

3800 persons of Killa block receiving social pension

Pension under different social pension schemes of the Union and State governments is being provided to total 3800 beneficiaries of Killa block. Among them, 1747 persons are receiving Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension. 134 persons are receiving Indira Gandhi National Widow Pension and 16 persons are receiving Indira Gandhi Divyangan Pension. Total 1903 beneficiaries have been benefited under different social pension schemes of the state government. Gomati district office of the

social welfare and social education department has informed this.

Total lockdown in border areas from July 17

In order to contain the COVID-19 pandemic the state government has announced total lockdown within 1 km. of border in rural areas and 0.5 km. in Municipal areas from 7 am. July 17, 2020 for seven days. In connection with this the government has also prohibited several activities like –

1. Movement of individuals except for emergency needs.
2. All kind of offices, business, commercial establishments, shops except selling grocery, vegetable, meat, fish, baby food and medicines and water.
3. All industrial establishments except those with continuous process.
4. All hotels and hospitality services.
5. All educational/research / training/ coaching institutions / all places of worship/ religious congregations.
6. All social / political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural /religious functions.
7. Up to 20 persons in case of funeral and 50 persons in marriage ceremonies will be allowed.

The government has also issued certain guidelines government offices/ PSUs in this regard. Not more than 20 participants will be allowed in official meeting and at least 1 meter gap should be maintained between two chairs in such meetings. Use of face mask, hand sanitiser etc. are also there. All auditoriums like Pragna Bhavan, Rabindra Bhavan will not be allowed to hold any programme. All offices should be sanitized daily.

Officers returning from leave may be quarantined as per the health department's guidelines. Any official developing ARI/ILI symptoms must be brought to the notice of the head of office and necessary medical examination should be arranged. The state government has informed this through a press release yesterday.

Health cum nutrition awareness camps in Mohanpur from July 16

Total 29 rural health cum nutrition awareness camps will be organized by the Mohanpur community health centre in different places of Mohanpur block between July 16 to 23. The camps will be held in Jamighat Anganwadi centre, Shanti para Anganwadi centre, Hrishi para Anganwadi centre, Gopal nagar Anganwadi centre, Devapur Anganwadi centre, Mohinipur Anganwadi centre and

South Bijoy Nagar Anganwadi centre of Mohanpur block on July 16. On the same date, camps will be held in Laxmipura Anganwadi centre, Damdamia Anganwadi centre, Kalapania Anganwadi centre of Bamutia block, Ganga Gatipur Anganwadi centre, Tulabagan Anganwadi centre, Colony Anganwadi centre No-3 of Mohanpur municipal council area.

The camp at Takkanagar Anganwadi centre of Mohanpur block will be held on July 18. Camps will be held in Kalikarmura Anganwadi centre of Mohanpur block and Mohanpur Anganwadi centre of Mohanpur municipal council area on July 20. The camps will be held in SBC Anganwadi centre, Rangchhara Anganwadi centre, Goutam Debnath Anganwadi centre, Nowagao Anganwadi centre, Bramhapukur Anganwadi centre, Kapali para Anganwadi centre of Mohanpur block on July 23.

The camps will be held in Sukunta para Anganwadi centre, Damdamia Anganwadi centre, Juba Tara Anganwadi centre of bamutia block and CSK para Anganwadi centre, Tulabaganur Anganwadi centre No-3 and Bhumihin Colony Anganwadi centre of Mohanpur Municipal Council area on July 23.
