

## Solar street lights in Kailasahar

Tripura Renewable Energy Development Agency, under the Ministry of Renewable Energy, has taken initiative to install 110 solar street lights in the sub-division. 20 solar street lights will be installed in Moruibari village, 17 in hirchara village, 15 in Maguruli Panchayat, 15 in Rangauti Panchayat, 15 in Latiyapura Panchayat, 16 in Samrurpar Panchayat and 4 in BSF Mike BOP. Apart from those, 4 solar street lights have been kept to install when necessary. Expenditure for installing each solar street light is 22 thousand 600 rupees.
