

Veterinary health camps going on in Jampuijala

Health camps are being organized in different villages of Jampuijala to treat ulcers in mouth and legs of cattle. On May 14, vaccination was administered on 200 cattle of Mahim Chowdhurypara, Haribandhupara and Saranjoy Sardarpara of Jampuijala ADC village. Veterinary workers of Jampuijala veterinary centre administered vaccines free of cost in every village. After vaccination serial number and seal were put on the ear of every cow. Veterinary doctor Milton Debbarma informed, the process of vaccination started on May 1 and this will continue till May 31. So far vaccination has been done for 1400 cows.

State Government to provide text books to private Bengali medium schools

The state government would provide free text books for class- I to VIII to private Bengali medium schools this year. Education minister Ratanlal Nath has announced this at a press conference in the civil secretariat on May 14. He said the state government, in view of the Covid-19 situation, has decided to take this initiative.

He said, after taking over, the present government has introduced NCERT course with the objective of providing quality education to the students of the state. Toward this direction, initiative has been taken to ensure NCERT curriculum-based education in every school for the classes from I to X. He informed that NCERT publishes text books in three languages – English, Hindi and Urdu across the country. Tripura is the state in the entire country to translate the text books in Bengali. He acknowledged the role of the teachers of the state in translating the books.

He also informed that total 25, 37,107 books are required for Class-I to VIII. But the state government ordered for printing of 26, 25,865 books and received

25,39,715 books. Among these, 24, 25,865 books have already been distributed among the students and the process is on to distribute the remaining books. He also informed that total 4.24 lakh books are required for the class –IX. 37,400 books have already reached. The supply of remaining books is being disrupted due to Covid-19 situation. Total 4.66 lakh books are required for class-X. Among these, 2, 26,820 books have reached. Total 2.68 lakh books are required for class-XII. 80,200 books have reached. The supply of remaining books for class-X and Class-XII is being disrupted due to Covid-19.

MGNREGA activities in Old Agartala block

Various activities are going on in different gram panchayats and ADC villages under Old Agartala block under MGNREGA. A pond is being dug in Briddhinagar gram panchayat. A amount of Rs. 3.69 lakh will be spent on this and 1800 mandays will be generated from it. Earth leveling work at two places and digging of irrigation channels at two places are going on in Debram Thakurpara ADC village. To implement these works Rs. 3,62,440 will be spent and 1768 mandays will be generated. An earth leveling work is also going on in Dhupchera gram panchayat. This will incur an expenditure of Rs. 1,81,425 and generate 885 mandays.

Over 14,000 persons getting social pension in Mohanpur
