Poverty alleviation standing committee reviews work

Under Atal Jaldhara scheme till now drinking water connections have been given to 18,527 families of eight blocks of Gomati district and Udaipur and Amarpur Municipal Council, informed the DWS official during a review meeting of the alleviation related poverty standing committee of Gomati Zilla Parishad held yesterday, the meeting was attended by the Sabhadhipati Swapan Adhikari, Saha-Sabhadhipati Debal Debroy, other members and officials of various departments.

It was also informed in the meeting that during the current financial year 105 new deep tube wells will be installed in Gomati district. So far work has been completed for seven deep tube wells, the rest will be done very soon. Target for small bore tube well has been set at 92 of which 12 have been done.

The rural development department's representative of Udaipur division informed, a brick soling road and a concrete canal have been constructed in Tepania panchayat of Tepania block. Besides, concrete canal, RCC box culvert etc. have been constructed in Salgarah, Dhwajanagar panchayat also. One modern

passenger shed has been constructed under MLA development fund. A community hall has been constructed in Dewanbari ADC village. The official of Amarpur division of RD said, four out of nine constructions works have been completed in the current financial year. The forest department official informed, forestation has been done along 136 km. road under MGNREGA during the current financial year.

The break-up of the cultivation goes like this -30 ha. in Mohanpur block, 10 ha. in Lefunga, 45 ha. in Bamutia, 25.40 ha. in Jirania, 27.20 ha. in Old Agartala, 50 ha. in Dukli and 30 ha. in Mandwi block area. Cultivation is going on over 30 ha. land in Hezamara block and 20 ha. land in Belbari block. West district horticulture and soil conversation department office has informed this.
