To groom the sports talents we need international standard sports infrastructure. That is why the present government is giving utmost importance to development of sports infrastructure, stated the information and cultural affairs minister Sushanta Chowdhury on March 5 after laying the foundation stone of a synthetic football turf at BKI ground, Belonia. He said, to dig out sports talent from the remote areas even sports equipments are being provided to 206 coaching centres of the state so that no talent is left behind for want of facilities. The state government has allocated huge budget for this purpose and very soon 150 junior sports teachers will be recruited.

Among others present on the occasion were director of the youth affairs and sports department Subikash Debbarma, chairperson of Belonia MC Nikhil Chandra Gope and other dignitaries. The minister also distributed sports equipments in 24

coaching centres including football, volley ball, hockey, Kabbadi, judo equipments.

### **House for 1,168 families in Mohanpur under PMAY (Urban)**

In the present financial year under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) scheme, Pucca houses are being constructed for 1 thousand 168 families of 15 ward areas under Mohanpur Municipal Council. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees will be spent in building each house. This was informed by Mohanpur Municipal Council office recently.

### **Assistance for duck rearing in Dhalai district under CMSPY**

In the present financial year under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana, assistance for duck rearing is being given to 574 families of 7 blocks under Dhalai district with the initiative of Animal Resources Development Department. Deputy Director of ARDD, Dhalai district Dr. Rahul Dhar Purkayastha recently informed that 45 families of the district have already received assistances under this scheme. 45 families out of 124 families of Ambassa Block under the district have received assistance recently. It has been informed that 85 families of

Salema Block, 10 of Ganganagar Block, 89 of Dumboor Nagar Block, 39 of Raisyabari Block, 68 of Chawmanu Block and 159 beneficiary families of Manu Block will be given assistance under this scheme. 1 thousand 300 rupees is being spent per family. Total expenditure will be 7 lakh 46 thousand 200 rupees.
