

Assistance to farmers of Chandul ADC village

Three hundred thirteen farmers of Chandul ADC village under Mohanbhog block have been covered under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi and 315 farmers of the same village have been brought under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana during the current financial year. Each of 100 farmers have received 3100 fish fingerlings for fish farming. Moreover, pump sets have been distributed among 14 farmers, spray machines have been given to four farmers, weeding tools have been given to five farmers at subsidized rate. Besides, high yielding paddy will be cultivated in 10 ha. land of the village under SRI system during this season, informed the Mohanbhog agriculture subdivision office.

Assistance for fish farming in Rupaichhari block

Assistance will be provided by the Rupaichhari fishery superintendent's office to fish farmers families of Rupaichhari block under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during the current financial year for making them self-reliant through scientific fish cultivation. Eight hundred pollens will be provided to each of 28 beneficiaries of the block for production of fingerling. Rs.

20,000 will be spent for each family for this purpose. Fishery officer of Rupaichhari block Dipankar Saha has informed this.

Administrative-cum-health camp at Madhya Ghaniamara ADC village

A day-long administrative-cum-health camp was organized by Sepahijala district administration at Garobazaar of Madhya Ghaniamara ADC village in Jampuijala block. The health department distributed medicines among 45 persons after their medical examination. Covid vaccine was administered on five persons and spectacles were distributed among 13 patients under Chief Minister Drishti Mission free of cost. Besides, the sub-divisional administration received 51 applications for PRTC, 46 applications for ST certificate, 12 applications for income tax certificate and nine applications for AADHAAR card. ARD department provided medicines for 157 domestic animals. DM of Sepahijala district Vishwasree B. was present in the camp. Discussion was held on different development issues of the village. DM also informed that the village has been selected for developing it into a model village. Among others present were SDM Sanjit Debbarma, BDO of Jampuijala

block Barun Debbarma and other officials of line departments.

New bridge in Mirza

2.20 km far from Udaipur Mirza to Shamukchara road above a rivulet, a 25 m long and 9.50 m wide pucca bridge construction has been completed under the supervision of PWD (Roads & Bridges) Udaipur division investing 2 crore 54 lakh 13 thousand rupees. The newly built bridge has been opened for transport. Farmers will be able to easily transport their agricultural produce to nearby markets. Earlier they had to face certain difficulties for this. This bridge will play a key role in transportation of goods as well as bring ease to communication between District Sadar and Block Sadar. This was informed in a press release by PWD (Roads & Bridges).

Pucca bridge constructed over Laljuri rivulet

About 100 m far from Laljuri main road, a 20 m long and 8.4 m wide pucca bridge has been constructed over Laljuri rivulet. The bridge was constructed under the supervision of PWD (Roads & Bridges) Kumarghat division investing 1 crore 47 lakh 26 thousand 903 rupees. Along with this, on the opposite side, a 250 metre long road has also been constructed. Through this bridge, farmers will be able to easily transport their produce to

nearby markets. Apart from this, communication has been built up between Laljuri-Moshauli to 82 mile bazaar and communication with Kanchanbari hospital, NH208, Fatikroy, Kumarghat sub division and with district headquarters Kailasahar has improved. This was informed by PWD (Roads & Bridges).

Water connection to 1104 houses in Gournagar block

Free water connections have been given to 1104 families of six Gram Panchayats in Gournagar block under Atal Jaldhara Mission. In August till 7th, 105 families from Bhagaban nagar, 95 from East Iyajekhawra, 74 from Phulbarikandi, 284 from Goldharpur, 373 from Gournagar, 173 from Ichabpur have been given free water connection.

5,011 farmers of Jolaibari brought under PMFBY

More farmers of Jolaibari agricultural sub division in Kharif season have been brought under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana exceeding the target of 4500 farmers. Total 5,011 farmers have been brought under this scheme. Besides, 5,121 farmers in Bagafa agricultural sub division have been brought under this scheme.
