

CM COVID special monetary benefit transferred to 25,623 families in Kamalpur

Along with the state transfer of financial assistance worth Rs. 1000 under the Chief Minister COVID Special Relief Package has started in Kamalpur subdivision also. Under the scheme Antyoday, Priority Household and identified APL families will get this benefit which is being transferred to their AADHAAR linked bank accounts through the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department. In Kamalpur subdivision, out of 26,148 families, 25,623 families have already received the benefit, informed the subdivisional food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department.

CM COVID Special Relief Package starts in Kanchanpur

Distribution of relief kits under the Chief Minister COVID Special Package had started from ration shop no. 3 in Kanchanpur subdivision yesterday. On the day relief kits were distributed among 196 families under ration shop no. 3. The inaugural programme was attended by executive member of TTAADC

Bhabaranjan Reang, Laljuri BAC chairman Sudhangshu Debnath, SDM in charge Himendu Bikash Paul, BDO Pinku Debbarma and other dignitaries. In Kanchanpur subdivision total 16,982 families will be covered under the CM COVID Special Package.

Infrastructural works done by Kamalpur NP

To ensure better standard of living in Kamalpur Nagar Panchayat area several pucca drains were constructed during the last financial year. These drains were constructed with the fund of urban development department. A drain was constructed in Ward no. 1 adjacent to Dhalai BOP spending Rs. 4,85,314 and at Bhagat Singh Chowmuhani of Ward no. 6 a retaining wall was constructed including earth filling for which Rs. 4,84,696 was spent. From Ward no. 8 embankment to PWD office via Kamalpur-Ambassa road RCC slab work and pucca drain construction incurred an expenditure of Rs. 4.85 lakh. In Ward no. 6, the pucca drain adjacent to Kamalpur sub-jail link road to northern side pucca drain has been extended by 17 metre. Rs. 52,063 has been spent in this work. Kamalpur

ARDD up for self-reliance of 200 families in Jirania

On the part of the animal resources development department initiative has been taken to make 200 families of Jirania subdivision self-reliant under Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. Under the scheme 50 families from each of Belbari, Mandwi, Old Agartala, and Jirania block will benefit. As part of this, each beneficiary will receive hybrid goat and ancillary materials. For this, Rs. 7,500 will be spent on each beneficiary. This information has been provided by the deputy director's office of animal resources development in Jirania.

Development activities under SASCE Scheme

Works of infrastructural development have been taken up by the water resources department under the Special Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure Scheme during the current financial year. One of the works up the sleeve is – construction of a sluice gate over Kanchichera in Melaghar Municipal Council area spending Rs. 12,41,16,000. Under the same scheme, special renovation of Maharani barrage will be done. On this work an amount of Rs.

3,32,27,000 will be spent. Besides, a pucca drain will be constructed to drain the flood water from Dharmanagar. Rs. 72.91 lakh will be spent in this work. This information has been provided by the headquarters of water resources department.

11,249 Farmers received financial assistance under PM Kisan in Sabroom
