Door-step health care facilities being provided for elderly

Under the National Programme for the Health Care of Elderly (NPHCE) free health care services are being provided to the senior citizens from every health centre. This includes door-to-door service as well. This scheme was taken up by the National Health Mission to ensure health security to the 'gray population'. As a part of this, on December 15, Dr. Ananya Das, CHO, supervisor, ASHA workers went to provide door-step health service to five patients. Of them, three were bed-ridden cancer patients and two had cardio-vascular issues.

bedded Rainagar community health centre yesterday. An amount of Rs. 4.78 crore has been spent in construction of the building. Earlier this hospital was 10bedded. Addressing the gathering at the Rajnagar Colony H.S. School ground on this occasion the chief minister said, Sabroom

will be the corridor to Northeast India once the Special Economic Zone is completed. For South Tripura district Rs. 573.99 crore has been sanctioned under six projects. The chief minister also deliberated on other development activities going on in the field of education, rural development, agriculture, tourism etc. The chief minister was hopeful that the people of South Tripura will get benefits of all these initiatives in next two-three years. Malaria identification camps in Gandachera

To identify malaria blood tests are being done through Rapid Diagnostic Kit (RDK) throughout the state. Two such camp were organized at Kashrai Para and Raban Para in Gandachera subdivision of Dhalai district on December 15. In the camp 21 people had availed health check-up and seven people had gone for blood test but none of them has been identified with malaria. MPW, ASHA workers and ASHA facilitators were active in executing these camps. Additionally they have been spreading awareness about use mosquito net in the concerned areas. PMAY houses for 674 families in Panisagar & Damchhara

Construction of house for 674 families is going on in Panisagar and Damchhara blocks of Panisagar subdivision under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Rural). Among these, construction of 383 houses

have been completed till now. Under the scheme, Rs 1.30 lakh is being spent for construction of each house. Houses are being constructed for 311 families in Panisagar block under the scheme.
