Smart phones for Anganwadi workers in Kailashahar

On behalf of the social welfare and social education department smart phones have been given to 280 Anganwadi workers of Kailashahar sub-division for performing official work. Out of the total beneficiaries, 119 were from Gourbagar Block, 125 from Chandipur Block, and 36 from Kailashahar Municipal Council area. Sujit Das, supervisor in charge of the Unakoti district social welfare and social education office, has informed this.

Agri-equipments for farmers in Jolaibari

During the last financial year various agricultural equipments were distributed among 82 farmers of Jolaibari Block area. The equipments were given from the BAC and Panchayat Development Fund. Under the programme hand-driven sprayers were given to 57 farmers spending Rs. 57,000 and pump machines were given to 25 farmers at the cost of Rs. 50,000. This information has been given by the Jolaibari Block office.

Mini-stadium in Boxanagar under MGNREGA

Under MGNREGA a mini-stadium and a two-storey housing are being constructed

at the site adjacent to Boxanagar HS School during the current financial year. An amount of Rs. 1.19 crore will be spent in work. The rural development department is implementing the project. Under the same scheme, brick-soling will be done over 550 metre road in Kalamchoura Gram Panchayat, brick soling of 450 metre road in Matinagar Gram Panchayat, brick soling of 820 metre road in Kulubari Gram Panchayat, and brick soling of 660 metre road in Dhanirampur village will be done. To construct 2,480 metre road in four gram panchayats a total of Rs. 38.9 lakh will be spent. This information has been given by the RD department office at Bishramganj.

Deep tube well to be installed at Purnirampara

A deep tube well will be installed by the drinking water and sanitation department at Purniram Para in Dayarampara ADC village under Jampuijala Block. This deep tube well will be installed with the fund sanctioned during the last financial year under the NRDWP scheme. This will incur an expenditure of Rs. 22,56,150. Once the project is completed 60 families of Purniram Para and 51 families of Rammanik Para will get drinking water facility.
