

16 Deep tube wells in West Tripura district

16 Deep tube wells have been installed so far in the present financial year in West Tripura district. Seven deep tube wells are being installed presently. Target has been set to install total 95 deep tube wells in the current financial year in different blocks of the district. Apart from that, two old deep tube wells were replaced.

Plans have been taken to install 545 non deep tube wells and start them in the district. Among those, 28 non deep tube wells are being installed. Plans have also been taken to set up 75 iron removal plants, among which two were set up and nine are being set up. Plans have been taken up to extend 620.500 km pipeline to provide drinking water to different block areas in West Tripura district. Recently 92.056 km pipeline has been extended. Target has been set to provide free drinking water connection to 44,512 families in the present financial year, where 8,755 families have already been given water connection. So far 15 crore 84 lakh rupees was spent in implementing the plans. This information was collected from the drinking water and sanitation department's executive engineer Ajit Debnath.

Mega health camp at Karbook: 176 patients treated

A mega health camp was organized by All Tripura Government Doctors' Association and family welfare and preventive medicine department with the help of Karbook community health centre on September 15. Twenty specialists were present in the mega health camp at Karbook community health centre wherein 620 patients availed of health care facilities. In the camp 176 patients were treated in medicine department, 80 patients in gynaecology, 85 children, 113 patients of eye problem, 19 patients of skin problem, 40 patients of orthopedic issues, 19 patients of ENT issues, 17 patients of neuro-issues and 35 patients of other departments received treatment. Ultra sonography facility was availed by 63 patients, whereas minor surgeries were done on three children and three adult patients. Doctors from Agartala Government Medical College, IGM

Hospital and Gomati district hospital took part. On the part of the organizers it was informed that this kind health camps will be continued in other parts of the state in coming days.

New roads under PMGSY in Unakoti district

Quite a few important road construction works are being done under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana section of PWD, Kumarghat division in Unakoti district. 8.061 km road from DK road to KK road via Tailenbari is being constructed. The project cost has been estimated to be 9 crore 98 lakh 79 thousand rupees. A 3.074 km road from DK road to KK road via a road opposite to Shib bari is also being constructed spending 4 crore 95 lakh 71 thousand rupees. A 4.108 km road from Depachara to Kalaigiri Chetlangbari is also being constructed for which project cost will be 4 crore 69 lakh 71 thousand rupees. Apart from that, construction work of NH8 to Haldichara 7.834 km road, Singerbil PWD road to Mahendra Choudhury road to again Singerbil PWD road measuring 2.564 km and Kailasahar (Municipal area) Old Duktunglow to Rangauti 7.09 km road has started under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana-Phase II. Project cost of constructing these three roads is 8 crore 44 lakh 78 thousand 900 rupees, 2 crore 74 lakh 80 thousand

rupees and 7 crore 9 lakh 79 thousand rupees respectively. This information was collected from PWD Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, Kumarghat division SDO Gopen Chandra Shil.

8,33,085 Mandays created under MGNREGA in Bokafa block

Permanent assets were created in 22 Panchayats and villages of Bokafa block. Different developmental works such as agricultural land leveling, construction of road, channel creation etc were implemented. So far 2 thousand 348 works were done spending 19 crore 24 lakh 99 thousand rupees. 8 lakh 33 thousand mandays were created through these activities. This information was collected from Bokafa block office.

New UPHC for animals at Dhumachara

A new UPHC of 45.36 square metre area was constructed with the initiative of animal resources development department at Dhumachara in Manu block in present financial year. Construction cost was 6 lakh 60 thousand rupees. One stockman sub centre has also been built at Mainama ADC village under Chailengta veterinary hospital spending 6 lakh 80 thousand rupees. Till date 9 calves were born this September in the area under Chailengta veterinary hospital

under Mukhyamantri Unnat Godhan Prakaalp.

Assistance for cashew nut cultivation to 20 tribal families in Satchand block

With the initiative of agriculture and farmer's welfare department in present financial year, 20 tribal families of Harbatali and Kalapania ADC villages of Satchand block have been given assistance for cashew nut cultivation under MGNREGA. Cashew nut is being grown on 20 Ha area in Harbatali and on 3 Ha area in Kalapania. 200 cashew saplings were given to each cashew nut farmer per hectare. 255 mandays were generated in creating garden on per hectare basis. Expenditure was 54,060 rupees and 45,299 rupees was invested in other works. This information was collected from agriculture supervisor Jiten Tripura of Satchand agricultural sub division.

Assistance to 20 beneficiaries for animal rearing under CMSPY

15 Selected beneficiaries were given assistance for pig rearing and five selected beneficiaries were given assistance for goat rearing under the initiative of animal resource development department under

Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana scheme on September 16 at Fatikchara Gram Panchayat office campus. Beneficiaries were given one piglet each and one goat cub each through a small programme. 1 lakh 72 thousand 500 rupees was invested on implementation of the program. Mohanpur ARDD office's joint director Dr. Shipra Das, Dr. Arunabh Sarkar and social activist Nani Deb were present in the programme.

Assistance for animal rearing in Sabroom under CMSPY

66 Beneficiary families in Rupaichari block were distributed chicks under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. The beneficiaries were given 10 chicks and 2 kg chick feed through a programme on September 15 at South Manubankul ADC village. ARDD officer Palika Debbarma informed that 66 beneficiary families of North Bijaypur, Bagmara and Chalitabankul ADC villages were distributed chicks. Rupaichari BAC chairman Dhananjay Tripura, ARDD deputy director Amitabh Das Gupta, joint director Kamaljit Debbarma, Rupaichari block BDO Shubhabrata Dey were present in the distribution programme.

4,917 Pucca houses to be constructed in Dukli block under PMAY

On the basis of 2011 socio-economic cast census, Pucca houses will be constructed for 4,917 beneficiaries of Dukli block in Sadar sub division under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Registration of beneficiaries is being done for this purpose. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees will be invested in constructing each house and 95 man-days will be spent through MGNREGA. This information was collected from Dukli block development office.

Assistance for animal rearing in North Tripura district under CMSPY

With the initiative of animal resources development department, assistance for animal rearing was given under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in North Tripura district. 15 beneficiaries of Jubarajnagar block in Dharmanagar sub division were given 1 piglet each to help them become self-reliant through animal rearing. 50 beneficiaries of Panisagar sub division and 6 beneficiaries of Jampuihill block of Kanchanpur sub division were given 1 piglet each. This information was collected from deputy director Pran Kumar das, Dharmanagar office in North Tripura district.

Drinking water source creation in Jirania

With the initiative of drinking water and sanitation department, different plans were taken in Jirania sub division to solve water crisis. 6 thousand 511 families in Jirania block of the sub division were provided with clean drinking water connection under Atal Jaldhara Mission. Apart from this, initiatives have been taken to install 15 tube wells and 22 mini deep tube wells in all those areas of the sub division where water crisis still exists. Plans have been taken to increase the capacity of water treatment plant at Jirania Nagar Panchayat area. 3 thousand 762 families under Atal Jaldhara Mission were given water connection in Belbari block.

Apart from this, 8 tube wells, 6 water tanks and 84 mini tube wells will be installed. 4 thousand 555 families in Old Agartala block have got water connection. Apart from this, plans are there to install 19 deep tube wells and 34 mini deep tube wells. This information was collected from Jirania DWS department sub divisional office.
