

CM addresses North-East Festival – 2020 in Guwahati

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has given a new identity to the Northeastern states. Under the leadership of Prime Minister all the Northeastern states are marching towards development. These were the remarks made by the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb today in Guwahati while addressing the North-East Festival – 2020.

The chief minister said, there was a time when the Assam-Agartala road was the only national highway in Tripura. But at present Tripura has seven lifelines. The rail communication system has also improved a lot. At the same time, rail link is being developed with Bangladesh also. Transportation of goods by water ways through Gomati river has also started on experimental basis. Construction of the bridge over Feni River will be completed by December, 2020. Then connection will be established with Chittagong also. The construction of Agartala International airport will also be completed by January.

Bailey Bridge in Ambassa

Various developmental works are being implemented in Ambassa sub-division by the Municipal Council in the current fiscal year. Recently, Kamalpur-Ambassa road has been re-carpeted and repaired spending 75 lakh rupees. Metalling, carpeting on 600m road and drainage

system were built in Dolubari under ward No. 1 of Ambassa MC with the financial assistance from Ambassa PWD spending 35 lakh rupees. Apart from that, 1 Bailey bridge was constructed in Govindapara of Ward No. 12 spending 51 lakh rupees.
