

West district horticulture office takes up cash crop plantation for poor famers

The West district office of the horticulture and soil conservation department has taken initiative to raise fruit and cash crop plantation in 12.60 ha. land of 19 poor farmers of Jirania block. To implement this project Rs. 18,54,593 will be spent under MGNREGA. A total of 3,947 mandays will be generated through this. The project plan is like this – banana plantation in 1.60 ha. land of four farmer families, lemon plantation in 2.40 ha. land of one family, areca nut plantation in 8.2 ha. land of 13 families, mango plantation in 0.40 ha. land of one family. Already plantation has been completed in 6.30 ha. land of 14 farmers. Rs. 6,16,540 has been spent for this generating 2,583 mandays. The West district horticulture and soil conservation department office has informed this.

Disaster mock drill in Amarpur

Under the aegis of Amarpur subdivisional administration a mock drill of disaster management was conducted in Amar Sagar lake and Gomati river in Mailak village. In both the cases techniques of

how to save life in disaster situation were exhibited. The staffs of fire service and TSR jawans took part in the mock drill following social distance. BDO Richard Jongte, DCM Shivjyoti Datta and other officials were present there.

Different works under Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan in Dhalai

Different development works are being implemented in different schools of Dhalai district under Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan. Additional classroom, toilet, source of drinking water, ramp for Divyanggan students etc are being constructed in the schools in the 2018-19 financial year. Among these, one additional class room has been constructed in Gejachhara SB School under Chhamanu ADC inspectorate of schools, Rajrendra RP J.B School and Manipuri para JB School under Kumtaiya ADC inspectorate of schools. Rs 7 lakh 20 thousand has been spent for construction of each class room.

Three class rooms at Indrajoy para JB School under Gandachhara ADC inspectorate of schools have been constructed at the cost of Rs 20 lakh. Rs 3.63 lakh has been spent for construction of the toilet at Hejachhara High school

under Chhailengta inspectorate of schools. Rs 3.63 lakh has been spent for construction of the toilet of Bhubanchhara High school under Kamalpur inspectorate of schools. Rs 2.9 lakh has been spent for construction of the toilet for Divyangan students of Kalachhari H.S School under Kamalpur inspectorate of schools.

One M-III tube well has been installed at Kanailal Halampara High School, Chulubari High School and Bhubanchhara High School under Kamalpur inspectorate of schools, Kanchanchhara High School, under Chailengta Inspectorate of School office at the cost of Rs 1.11 lakh for installation of each M-III tube well. Moreover, houses for the teachers of Jagabandhu H.S School in Gandachhara subdivision and Ganganagar English Medium H.S School in Ganganagar block have been constructed. The office of Dhalai district education officer has informed this.

Paddy procurement from farmers completed in Khowai

The process of paddy procurement by the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department from the farmers of Khowai subdivision at minimum support price (MSP) has been completed. In total 2398

quintal paddy has been purchased by the department from 157 farmers of the subdivision from June 6-15 at the government procurement centre at Ganki in Khowai. The chief inspector of the subdivision office of the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs Babul Das has informed that paddy has been purchased from the farmers at MSP of Rs 1815 per quintal.

Assistance provided to 4129 farmers of Matabari under PM Kisan Samman Niddhi

Assistance has been provided to 4129 farmers in Matabari agri-subdivision under PM Kisan Samman Niddhi. Rs 6000 has been provided to the beneficiaries in three installments under the scheme.

Moreover, 12 new water reservoirs have been excavated in the block for irrigation purpose in agriculture-land under PM Krishi Sinchan Yojana. Rs 4 lakh has been spent for this purpose. One check dam has been constructed at the cost of Rs 1.30 lakh. Matabari agri-subdivision office has informed that 20 power tillers were distributed among 20 beneficiaries of the block for cultivation purpose at a subsidy of Rs 85000 under the Mission Scheme.
