Rs. 35.52 crore collected in Khowai under Small Savings Scheme

During the 2019-20 financial year an amount of Rs. 35.52 crore has been collected in Khowai district under Small Savings scheme. For the said period target for collection was Rs. 35 crore. Giving this information the small savings officer of Khowai district said, under the scheme Rs. 13.6 crore has been collected from Khowai district and Rs. 22.50 crore has been collected in Teliamura subdivision.

Solar lanterns distributed in Jampuijala

Solar lanterns have been given free of cost to students to facilitate their studies under 'Solar Study Lamp' scheme. Under the scheme 65 students of Tanpui village under Killa Verma ADC village and 30 students of Owaighati village under Chhaigharia ADC village in Jampuijala RD block have benefited. These solar lanterns have been distributed through two different programmes at Tanpui JB School in Kill Verma ADC village and Owaighati JB School ground. BDO of Jampuijala Barun Debbarma, additional CEO of TREDA and other officials were present on the occasion.

State government's delineation on lockdown 4 measures

To contain COVID-19 the National Executive Committee (NEC) had issued an order on May 17, 2020 and asked the states to delineate Red, Orange and Green Zones as per Para 5 of the related Guidelines issued by the Government of India on May 17, 2020. At the same time state governments have been asked to decide on inter and intra-state movement of passenger vehicles and buses as per the said Guidelines. Accordingly, the state government has decided that - (1) the Containment Zones notified by the DM and Collector will be treated as Red Zones; (2) The Buffer Zones around the Red Zones will be treated as Orange Zones; (3) all other areas outside the Red and Orange Zones will be treated as Green Zones in the state; (4) in the Orange and Green Zones there will be no restrictions except those mentioned in para 2 of the Guidelines of the Ministry of Home Affairs issued on May 17, 2020; (5) there will be no restrictions on intra-State movement of passenger vehicles and buses starting from anywhere terminating anywhere within the state and (6) the inter-state movement of passenger vehicles and buses will be

allowed by DM and Collector for stranded people, people with medical needs, business related travel and other urgent needs. The state government has informed this in an official order dated May 18, 2020.

MGNREGA activities going on in Jirania block

Various works are being implemented under MGNREGA in different gram panchayats and ADC villages of Jirania block. Among these, six earth leveling

works are going on in Barjala Binapani ADC village. Rs. 11.86 lakh will be spent in this and it will generate 4,500 mandays. In Bishrambari ADC village also earth leveling works are going on in five places. For this purpose an amount of Rs. 7.10 lakh will be spent to generate 2,770 mandays. On the other hand, in Durganagar gram panchayat earth leveling works are going on in four places and four irrigation canals are being dug. To implement these activities Rs. 8,40,500 will be required. A total of 3,250 mandays will be generated from these works.

MGNREGA activities in North Bodhjungnagar

Various works are being implemented under MGNREGA to create employment for the people of North Bodhjungnagar ADC village under Lefunga block during the lockdown period. Already under the scheme 1290 mandays have been generated. A total of 404 families have benefited from it. Spending Rs. 2,32,200 earth leveling, renovation of road, construction canal etc. activities have been implemented. At present more 3000 mandays are being generated under MGNREGA in the village. Through this 568 families will benefit. This information has been given from North Bodhjungnagar village.
