

Health camp at Chatakchhari under Anemia Free India programme

A health camp under Anemia-free India programme was held at Chatakchhari Health and Wellness centre under Rupaichhari PHC in South Tripura district on July 16. Moreover, an awareness programme was also organized in the camp. Hemoglobin test of 15 children and women was done in the camp. Among them, 10 persons were suffering from anemia. Arrangement of treatment for the patients was done immediately in the camp. As a part of awareness programme, ASHA workers provided health advice to pregnant women, lactating mother and children. National Health mission has informed this.

Malaria identification camp at Niranjana para

A health camp was organized at Niranjana para under Haludia health sub-centre of Mungiakami PHC on July 14 to detect patients affected by malaria. Blood sample of 31 persons including one patient suffering from fever was collected. Their blood samples were tested through RDT kit for detection of malaria. But no malaria parasite was found in anybody. Medical staffs provided medicine after

health checkup. Moreover, spraying of DDT in homestead, using of mosquito net while sleeping, cleaning surrounding area of house, etc topics were discussed. MTS, MPW and ASHA workers were present in the camp. Family welfare and preventive medicine department has informed this in a press release.

Assistance to traders under CMSY

Financial assistance is being given to traders of Kumarghat block area under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. In the current financial year, financial assistance of 1 thousand rupees each was given for insurance to 105 traders of Fatikroy market area. Total expenditure was 1 lakh 5 thousand rupees. The initiative will start gradually for other traders of different markets. This was informed by BDO Mithun Das Chowdhury.

3,182 houses in Manu & Chawmanu block under PMAY

Initiative has been Target has been taken to build 3,232 houses for beneficiary families of Manu and Chawmanu block in Longtharai Valley sub division, Dhalai district under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Rural). Out of which 3,182 houses are under construction. Beneficiary families have already received first, second and third installment of the

assistance. So far 1,919 houses were built in Manu block. Rest 189 houses are under construction. 1 lakh 30 thousand is being spent in building each house. Total expenditure for building 2,072 houses is 26 crore 93 lakh 36 thousand rupees. In Chawmanu 1,104 houses were built and 20 are under construction. Total expenditure in building 1,110 houses is 14 crore 43 lakh rupees. This was informed by Dhalai DM office.

Assistance to 3,300 families for duck and poultry farming

Assistance will be given to 3,300 families of 8 blocks of Dhalai district for duck and poultry farming under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana in the present financial year by ARDD. This was informed by Dr. Rahul Dhar Purkayashtha, Director, ARDD. Among those beneficiary families, 643 are from Durga chowmuni block, 426 are from Salema block, 371 from Ambassa block, 123 from Ganganagar block, 424 from Dumboornagar block, 196 from Raishyabari block, 338 from Chawmanu block and 769 from Manu block. Total expenditure will be 42 lakh rupees.

Assistance for betel nut & pineapple cultivation in Kanchanpur subdivision

taken by the horticulture and soil conservation department to cultivate

betel nut and pineapple in 13 hectare land of Kanchanpur subdivision during the current year. Assistance will be provided to the beneficiaries for cultivation of betel nut and pineapple in 4 hectare land of Dasda block, 4 hectare land of Laljuri block and 4 hectare land of Jampuihill block in the subdivision under the scheme. Rs 27, 1,147 will be spent for this purpose. Kanchanpur subdivision horticulture and soil conservation office has informed this.

Inauguration of North Rangamura Health sub-centre

North Rangamura Health Sub-centre under Radhanagar PHC in South Tripura district was inaugurated on July 15. A health camp was organized on the occasion of inauguration of the health sub-centre. Chairman of Rajnagar Panchayat Samiti Tapan Debnath, CMO of South Tripura district Dr. Jagadish Chandra Nama, SDMO Dr. Bimal Kalai and other officials were present in the inaugural programme. The programme was presided over by Pradhan of Rangamura Gram Panchayat Shital Das. 67 persons under the jurisdiction of the health camp were treated and provided required medicine. Spectacle was distributed among the aged persons. Dental treatment was provided to 13 persons in the camp. Tripura branch of National Health mission has informed this.
