3,579 Fish farmers to benefit under CM Swanirbhar Yojana in Khowai

During the current financial year 3,578 fish farmer families will be brought under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Yojana for their self-reliance. To be eligible for this scheme each fish farmer should have at least half kani water body. Under the scheme each beneficiary will be provided 500 fingerlings of Rui, Katla and Mrigel fish. Under this initiative 1.570 beneficiaries from Khowai block, 1,188 beneficiaries from Tulashikhar block, 820 beneficiaries from Padmabil block will be covered. As part of this each fish farmer will be given one-day training. Khowai fishery supervisor's office has provided this information.

25,405 Farmers to benefit under CM Swanirbhar Yojana in West district

Under the initiative of horticulture and soil conservation department 25,405 farmer families of different areas in West Tripura district will be brought under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Yojana during the current financial year. Under the scheme each beneficiary will get six papaya saplings, four lemon samplings,

and five areca nut saplings. For this purpose as per target total 1,52,432 papaya saplings, 1,01,621 lemon saplings, and 1,27,027 areca nut saplings will be distributed among 25,405 farmer families. In addition, 25,405 vegetable seed kits will be given to them. An amount of Rs. 12.70 lakh will be spent for providing the seed kits. West district horticulture and soil conservation office has provided this information.

23 Community sanitary complexes in South Tripura: Survey for ODF Plus begins

Under Swachch Bharat Mission (rural) so far 23 community sanitary complexes have been constructed in South Tripura district. Total Rs. 37.40 lakh has been spent in these works. As per the Government of India's survey in 2012, South Tripura district was declared ODF on February 1, 2019 after giving pucca toilets to 44,649 families. In addition, during 2019-20 and 2020-21 financial year 7,947 LOB toilets and 9,702 TNOLB toilets were constructed. During the current financial year 3,700 new toilets are being constructed. Besides, survey is going on

for starting ODF Plus work in every panchayat by ensuring pucca drainage and system in each village, school and Anganwadi centre. This information has been divulged by the South Tripura DM office.

216 housing under PMAY

So far houses have been constructed for 216 families of Dasda block in Kanchanpur sub division from 2019-20 budget under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Rural). Construction work of 41 houses is in progress. 1 lakh 30 thousand rupees is being spent for each housing. This was informed by Dasda Block office.

Various works under TUEP in Bishalgarh

Total 57 thousand 845 mandays were generated in 2020-21 fiscal year under TUEP in Bishalgarh municipal area. 86 lakh 34 thousand 545 rupees was spent for this purpose. Average working day was 26 days. It was informed from Bishalgarh Municipal Council office that under this scheme various developmental works including drainage systems were cleaned, roads were constructed, forests were

cleaned, water irrigation source were made in the municipal area.

Paddy procurement in Belonia

By the initiative of food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department and department of agriculture and farmer's welfare, paddy was procured at MSP from farmers on June 15 at Belonia cold storage campus. Paddy procurement process was held for eight days. There total 2 lakh 12 thousand 781 kg paddy was procured from total 114 farmers. This year MSP has been set to 18 rupees 68 paisa per kg. This was informed by the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department's Belonia sub division office.

5,141 Toilets in Manu & Chhamanu Block under Swachch Bharat Mission

Under Swachch Bharat Mission toilets have been constructed for 5,141 families in Manu and Chhamnu block of Dhalai district during the period from 2018-19 financial year to March, 2020-21 financial year. Rs. 12,000 has been spent in construction of each toilet. In total Rs. 6, 16, 92,000 has been spent on this. Member secretary of the Dhalai Swachch Bharat Mission office has informed this.
