

2,04,842 Mandays generated in Belbari block under MGNREGA

In the financial year 2021-22 under MGNREGA, different development works were done in Belbari block of Jirania sub-division at the cost of 3 core 80 lakh 71 thousand rupees. Total 2 lakh 4 thousand 842 mandays were generated in the implementation of activities like mini barrage construction, land levelling, creation of garden for dragon fruit cultivation, brick soling road construction, waterbody excavation for fish farming and creation of water irrigation sources. This was informed by Belbari Block Office.

5170.78 MT Cocoon produced in Champaknagar and Mohanpur

In the financial year 2021-22, 5170.78 MT Cocoon has been produced in Champaknagar and Mohanpur Cocoon Production Centers under West Tripura district. Houses have been constructed for 158 families of these two Production Centers for silkworm cultivation. Apart from that, for increasing production in the next financial year, target has been taken to bring more 240 families of Mohanpur, Dukli and Champaknagar area. Through

that 120 Acre land will be brought under mulberry cultivation. As a result, 80 families of Mohanpur area, 30 families of Dukli block area and 130 families Champaknagar area will be benefitted. This was informed by sericulture department, Mohanpur office.

Drinking water connection to 22,895 families of West Tripura district

In the financial year 2021-22 under Atal Jaldhara Mission, drinking water connection through pipeline has been provided to 22 thousand 895 families of West Tripura district. Apart from this, 108 new deep tube wells were installed in the district in the financial year 2021-22. 98 previously installed deep tube wells were started. Apart from that, under this Mission, 310 small bore wells were drilled and started. 90 small bore wells are under the process to start. This was informed by Drinking Water & Sanitation department, Agartala Division no. 2.

Ambulances given to 4 PHCs of Sepahijala district

Minister of State for Social Justice & Empowerment Pratima Bhowmik handed over ambulances to four Primary Health Centres of Sepahijala district through a

programme held in Bishramganj yesterday. These four PHCs are- Jampuijala PHC, Takarjala PHC, Kamalnagar PHC and Dhanpur PHC. 7 lakh rupees was spent on each ambulance. The ambulances were bought with SDRF fund. Others present during the event were Sabhadhipati of Sepahijala Zilla Parishad Supriya Das Datta, MLA Subhash Chandra Das and Sepahijala DM & Collector Vishwasree B.

Administrative cum health camp in Holong Mwtai ADC Village on April 29

An administrative-cum-health camp will be conducted in Holong Mwtai ADC Village of Tulashikhar block on April 29 with the initiative of Khowai sub-division administration. The administrative-cum-health camp will be conducted at Mayung Bekereng Kusum Para High School campus of the village area. Application for marriage certificate, PRTC, ST, income certificates and Aadhar card will be taken. Free health check-ups and medicines will be given by the health department. Khowai Sub-Divisional Magistrate invites locals to make the best use of these facilities being provided.

5 Deep tube wells in Amarpur sub-division under JJM

Five deep tube wells were installed in the financial year 2021-22 under Jal Jeevan Mission in Amarpur sub-division to create drinking water sources. Apart from this, 125 small bore wells were created. In the financial year 2021-22, free drinking water connection was provided to 8 thousand 982 families of the sub-division under the Mission.

In remote areas, water supply is being given through vehicle in five localities of Malbasa village, in five localities of East Sarbang village, in three localities of Guriya village and in a locality of Paharpur village. Work for creating drinking water source will soon start in these localities. This was informed by Drinking Water & Sanitation department, Amarpur office.

Drinking water connection to 35,745 families of Khowai district

In the financial year 2021-22 under Jal Jeevan Mission, drinking water connection has been provided to 36 thousand 745 families of Khowai district. 6 thousand 79 families of Kalyanpur block, 7 thousand 946 families of Khowai block, 3 thousand 349 families of Mungiakami block, 6 thousand 597 families of Padmabil block, 7 thousand 200 families

of Teliamura block and 5 thousand 574 families of Tulashikhar block were provided with drinking water connection through pipeline. This was informed by Executive Engineer of Drinking Water & Sanitation department Gopi Majumdar.

Assistance to 633 families of Mohanpur block under CMSPY

In the present financial year under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana, assistance will be provided to 633 beneficiary families of Mohanpur block for animal rearing. Assistance for poultry farming will be provided to 362 families of the block under the scheme. Each beneficiary family will be given 10 chicks. 4 lakh 70 thousand 600 rupees will be spent in its implementation. Apart from this, assistance for duck breeding will be provided to 121 families of the block. Each beneficiary family will be given 10 ducklings. 1 lakh 57 thousand 300 rupees will be spent in its implementation. Assistance for pig rearing will be provided to 100 families of the block under the scheme. 7 lakh 50 thousand rupees will be spent for this. Assistance for goat rearing will be provided to 50 families of the block under the scheme. 3 lakh 75 thousand rupees will be spent for this. This was informed by assistant director of Animal Resources Development Department, Mohanpur office Dr. Billu Debbarma.

Amarpur Block Level Health Fair to be held on April 26
