

5 PHCs upgraded into 10 bedded PHCs

Jamthung PHC of Dhalai district, Vidya Debbarma Memorial (Lefunga) PHC and Hejamara PHC of West district, Manughat PHC and Radhanagar PHC of South district under the health and family welfare department have been upgraded into 10 bedded PHCs (24x7 service) from New Norm PHC. The director of family and preventive medicine department informed this in a press release on November 19, 2020.

The Tripura Guaranteed Services to Citizen Rules-2020 approved in the State Cabinet

'The Tripura Guaranteed Services to Citizen Rules-2020 got approval in the State Cabinet to make it possible for people to get various government facilities within a specific period of applying for it,' said the education minister Ratan Lal Nath in a press conference in the Secretariat today. He said that the Tripura Guaranteed Services to Citizen Act-2020 was made for providing various necessary services like PRTC, Income Certificate, SC/ST/OBC Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Survival, Land valuation etc. in specific time period after applying for it. The Tripura

Guaranteed Services to Citizen Rules-2020 got approval according to this Act.

The education minister said that according to this rule, it will be put up on government office notice boards notifying the number of days within which the services will be given and in failure to provide this information one must complain to whom will also be specified on the notice board. Specific responsibility will be given to the officials to provide the services. In failure to provide the services within specific time period, the officials will be liable to be charged 20 rupees to 500 rupees maximum.

The education minister in the press conference said, 'Online admission procedures have already started in the state this year in 22 general Degree colleges having 43,381 seats among which pass courses are 34,942 and the rest are honours courses. Online admission was a demand for long time of students and their guardians.' He also said that 23,016 students have applied for online admission among which 13,123 students have already got admission in 1st, 2nd and 3rd round for both pass and honours courses.

At present, admissions are being done in 3.1 round which will continue till 25th

November, 2020. After this will commence the 4th round. The education minister assured that all those who have applied will surely be able to get admissions in colleges. He said that for the first time, integrated master degree courses for 5 years with 60 seats in chemistry has been started in the MBB University. He also informed that the examinations for the standard V, VIII, IX have recently been conducted under the “Bochor Bachao” programme. The examination for standard XII will end on 24th November. The results for all standards will be out on 30th November. Chandrasekhar Pillai, OSD, Higher Education department was also present in the press conference.

Assistance provided in Kadamtala agriculture subdivision under PM Kishan Samman Niddhi

16,924 farmers of Kadamtala and Kalachhara blocks in Dharmanagar MC under Kadamtala agriculture subdivision have been registered under PM Kisan Samman Niddhi Yojana. Each farmer is receiving Rs 2000 in each of three installments totaling Rs 6000 under the scheme. 8852 farmers of Kadamtala block have been registered. Among them, 8657 farmers received money of 1st installment, 8340 farmers received money of 2nd installment and 7656 farmers received

money of 3rd installment. 8076 farmers of Kalachhara block and Dharmanagar MC have been covered under the scheme. 7025 farmers received money of 1st installment, 6883 farmers received money of 2nd installment and 6396 farmers received money of 3rd installment. The North District office of the agriculture and farmers’ welfare department has informed this.

576 persons received social pension in Sabroom NP area

Pension is being provided by the social welfare and social education department to 576 persons in Sabroom Nagar Panchayat area under different social pension schemes. Among them, 350 persons are receiving pension under different social pension schemes of the state government. 226 persons are receiving pension under pension schemes of the Union government. Among them, 438 social pensioners are female and 138 social pensioners are male.
