

Seven habitations connected through all weather roads

Under PMGSY construction of 40 km. road has been completed during the period from April 1 to June 30 of the 2021-22 financial year. Through this seven habitations could be connected with all weather roads. Under PMGSY-III so far DPR of 254 km road has been prepared. PMGSY section of PWD has provided this information.

691 Toilets in Dukli block under Swachh Bharat Mission

During the 2020-21 financial year toilets were constructed for 691 families in Dukli block under Swachh Bharat Mission (rural). For this purpose Rs. 82.92 lakh was spent. Additionally, construction of toilets is going on in Malaynagar, Belabar and Bagmara Gram Panchayat of Dukli block and Rs. 9 lakh will be spent on this. On the other hand, under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (rural) houses are being constructed for 102 poor families of Dukli block during the 2020-21 financial year. Construction of 91 houses has been completed and work of 11 houses is going on, informed Dukli block office.

3681 Families to benefit under MSPY in Sepahijala district

Initiative has been taken to make 3,681 families of Boxanagar, Kathalia, Mohanbhog, Nalchhar, Jampuijala, Charilam and Bishalgarh block of Sepahijala district through animal rearing under Mukhyamantri Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. As part of this initiative, assistance will be given to 700 families for pig rearing, 350 families for goat rearing, and 594 families for duck farming and 2037 families for poultry farming.

Assistance to 30,060 families for animal rearing under CMSPY

Assistance is being provided by the animal resources development department to 30,060 families for duck, goat, poultry and pig farming through Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. As per the scheme, assistance is being provided to 17,088 families in the state for poultry farming. 10 chicks aged 28 days are being provided to each family. 20 Hybrid ducklings aged 28 days will be provided to 4272 families. Distribution of one yielding pig aged 2-3 months to 5800 beneficiary-families is also under progress. One hybrid pig aged 6-8 months will be provided to each of 2900 beneficiary-families. Two

block level brooder houses will be constructed in each district - West Tripura District, Sepahijala District and South Tripura District. Rs. 10 crore 55 lakh in total will be spent for this purpose during the current financial year. The office of the director of animal resources development department has informed this.

Concrete house for 44 families in Sabroom Nagar Panchayat

Concrete house will be raised for 44 families of Sabroom Nagar Panchayat under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana during the current financial year. Rs. 1,66,666 will be spent for construction of each house. Rs. 1 crore 56 lakh 66 thousand 6 hundred 4 has been granted to Sabroom Nagar Panchayat for construction of the houses under PMAY. Sabroom Nagar Panchayat Office has informed this.

Drinking water connection provided to 203 families in AMC

Initiative is going on to install domestic drinking water supply connection for the inhabitants living in different wards of Agartala Municipal Council. Till now, drinking water connection has been provided to 203 families in AMC under Atal Jaldhara Mission free of cost. Rs.

3,04,500 in total has been spent for this purpose. Executive engineer of Division-I office of DWS department has informed this.

Drinking water connections to 4,947 houses under Atal Jaldhara Yojana

Free drinking water connections are being given in rural areas under Atal Jaldhara Mission. From July 1 to July 18 this year, drinking water connections have been given to 4,947 families. Among them 602 families are from North district, 574 are from Unakoti district, 484 are from Dhalai district, 289 are from Khowai district, 762 are from West district, 804 are from Sepahijala district, 845 are from Gomati district and 587 houses are from South district. This was informed in a press release issued by the drinking water and sanitation department.

Paddy procurement in Bishramganj

240 MT Paddy was procured from 139 farmers at MSP Rs. 18.68 at Bishramganj mini stadium under Charilam block from July 12 to July 15, 2021 by the food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department and with the assistance of agriculture and farmer's welfare department. This was informed by Bishalgarh sub division agriculture supervisor Priyatosh Sarkar.
