

Waste management centre coming up at Sonamukhi

Kumarghat Municipal Council's waste management centre will soon be set up on 3 Acre land of Sonamukhi bagan in Unakoti district investing 1 crore 50 lakh rupees. Initiative has already been taken to set up the waste management centre. Both degradable and non-degradable wastes separately will be collected door to door from Kumarghat municipal areas and will be dumped at the waste management centre.

There are presently two centres in Kumarghat municipal area for separating degradable and non-degradable wastes. Two more waste separation centres will be set up soon. Each waste separation centre will be built spending 5 lakh 85 thousand rupees. This information was collected from Kumarghat municipal office.

A three-day Skill, Loan and Job Mela has started at Jolaibari HS school ground today under Sankalp scheme. The fair

organized by the District Skill Committee in collaboration with the directorate of skill development has been inaugurated by the chairman of Tripura Industrial Development Corporation Tinku Roy.

Speaking on the occasion TIDC chairman Tinku Roy said, this three-day long fair is a very significant for the youths of the state to be self-reliant. He said, the government has so far provided Rs. 50 crore to 1,951 beneficiaries under Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) and one Common Facilitation Centre would be set up in South Tripura with a project cost of Rs. 2 crore. On the other hand, 40 beneficiaries have received loan for incense stick unit with a subsidy of 60 per cent and the state government has spent about Rs. 15 crore for setting up a rice mill in North Tripura.

In the inauguration programme it was announced that Tripura Gramin Bank has sanctioned Rs. 3,44,48,000 to 202 loan accounts of SHGs from its 16 branches; Punjab National Bank has sanctioned Rs. 64 lakh to 43 loan accounts of SHGs mentored by TRLM in South Tripura from its four branches. Besides, revolving fund of Rs. 10,000 each has been given to four SHGs and revolving fund of Rs. 50,000 each has been given to two Area Level Federations in Belonia municipal area. In addition, Rs. 1 lakh loan has been given to Bholanath SHG under TRLM for self employment.

The inaugural programme was presided over by Saha Sabhadhipati of South Tripura Zilla Parishad Bibhishan Chandra Das. Others present on the occasion were MLA Shankar Roy, DM Saju Waheed, SEO of National Skill Development Corporation Shiladitya Sarkar, director of skill development in Tripura Sanjoy Chakraborty, SDM, Santirbazar Abhedananda Baidya and other guests and officials.

Assistance to 12 families in Bishalgarh sub division under CMASY

Under Chief Minister Antyodaya Shradhanjali Yojana, 12 families in Bishalgarh sub division have been

provided with assistance. Beneficiary families of Bishalgarh block, Charilam block and Bishalgarh municipal council areas of the sub division were given financial assistance of two thousand rupees per family. Among 12 beneficiary families, 1 family was from Bishalgarh municipal council area, 4 families were from Charilam block area and 7 families were from Bishalgarh block area.

Assistance to 1,564 families in Bishalgarh under CMSPY

1,564 Families of Bishalgarh block were given assistance by fisheries department

under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. In the present financial year, 11 Gram Panchayats of the block were provided with assistance. 44 families of Harishnagar Panchayat, 134 families of Gokulnagar Gram Panchayat, 130 families of South Madhupur Gram Panchayat, 125 families of Pathariyadar Gram Panchayat, 61 families of Bhatibari Gram Panchayat, 250 families of Kaiyadepa Gram Panchayat, 170 families of Arabindnagar Gram Panchayat, 114 families of Gajariya Gram Panchayat, 382 families of Golaghati Gram Panchayat, 112 families of Bhatirlama Gram Panchayat and 42 families of Madhya Lakhibil Gram Panchayat have benefitted through this initiative.

2,790 Farmers under PMFBY in Hezamara block

2 thousand 790 farmers of Hezamara block of Mohanpur sub division were brought under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana by Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare department. 2 thousand 627 farmers of 21 ADC villages of the block area were brought under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana. These beneficiary farmers are getting financial assistance of

six thousand rupees in three installments every year. This information was collected from Agriculture superintendent Ajit Debbarma, Hezamara Agriculture sub divisional office.

Assistance to 2,720 in Santirbazar families for pisciculture under CMSPY

2 thousand 720 families were provided with assistance in Santirbazar sub division in present financial year under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. Each beneficiary family was given 500 fish fingerlings. Beneficiary families of Takmachara, South Takma, Rajapur, Birchandranagar, Devipur, Kathaliachara ADC village, Subhash colony, Radhakishoreganj, Kanchannagar, Laugang Gram Panchayat of Bokafa block and beneficiary families of Kalsi, Kalsimukh ADC village, East Charakpai, Swadeshnagar, West Jolaibari, South Jolaibari, North Jolaibari, Muhuripur Gram Panchayat Jolaibari block received assistance.
