

Street library inaugurated at Amarpur motor stand

A street library was launched at Amarpur motor stand yesterday. Bi-cycles distributed among girl students

The government has given topmost priority to educational development. Resultantly, NCERT syllabus was introduced from first to twelfth standard in the schools. A total of 30,000 teachers have also been trained for that purpose, stated the education minister Ratan Lal Nath yesterday at the bi-cycle distribution programme for girl students held at Kabi Nazrul Higher Secondary School in Teliamura. Bi-cycles

are being distributed among the students from class-IX. This year 26,530 students will be covered under the programme.

The programme was also attended by the chief whip of Tripura Legislative Assembly Kalyani Roy, MLA Atul Debbarma. Headmaster of the school Bishuroy Debbarma presided over the occasion. In the programme bi-cycles were handed over to 101 girl students of four schools of Teliamura sub-division.

Health camp at Madhya Halaipar Anganwadi centre

World Diabetics Day was observed at Madhya Halaipar Anganwadi centre under Samrupar health centre on November 19. This health camp was organized under non-communicable disease scheme of the National Health Mission. Discussion was held on diabetes, effect on body and preventive measure etc.. Required medicines were provided to the patients free of cost. Beside this, blood pressure, blood sugar etc. tests had been done. The diabetic patients were requested to check blood pressure and blood sugar at hospital every month. Total 61 persons participated in the camp. Pradhan of Halaipur gram Panchayat Ratan Das and member Khela Shabdakar were present in the camp.

Apart from this, the beneficiaries will be given fish feed investing 5 Lakh 95 thousand 727 rupees.

Assistance given to 30 families for poultry farming in Khowai

With objective of making everyone Swanirbhar through poultry farming, assistance was provided to 30 beneficiaries of different panchayats of Khowai block with the help of ARDD Khowai sub-division office. 30 poultry chicks, poultry food and other basic things were given to each beneficiary for poultry farming in the current year under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana spending 5 thousand rupees for each beneficiary. 2,221 people getting social pensions in Mohanpur municipal area
