

CM inaugurates state of the art Building of Women ITI at Indranagar



Public welfare and economic development of the state is the main motto of the government. It is working tirelessly for the overall development of the state. Success has been achieved in several fields already, stated the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating the state of the art building of Women Industrial Training Institute, built under Model ITI scheme of the central government at Indranagar today. He visited different sections of the building. The building was built spending total 8 crore rupees, out of which 7 crore 20 lakh rupees was granted by the central

government and 80 lakh rupees was granted by the state government. The total area is 806.40 square meters. The building includes Cosmetology, Computer Aided Embroidery Design and Surveyor branches. 40 students can seek training in each of these trade sections.

The Chief Minister said, people's income has increased in the state as well as farmers monthly income to some extent. There are 26 thousand SHGs in the state at present, to which about 3.5 lakh women are attached. Their revenue has increased to about 1 thousand crore rupees. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has emphasized upon women empowerment to build a self-reliant country. The state government is also moving in the same direction. A positive environment has been created in the state presently for setting up of new industries. The demand of efficient people will be met from the students of such ITIs. The chief minister also said, about 400 students from ITI have been recruited in various fields in the state in the past three years. Others are also becoming self-reliant through different central and state government schemes.

Industry and commerce minister Manoj Kanti Deb in the inaugural programme said, ITI are the most important institutes to build self-reliant Tripura. There are total 19 ITIs in the state at present. Seven new ITIs have been set up in the four years of the government. Proposal has been sent to the central government recently to set up more ITIs.

TIDC Chairman Tinku Roy, addressing the gathering there informed, the exports have crossed 200 crore rupees in the present financial year in the state. It was possible as a result of changed environment brought about in industrial sector. Just recently 250 crore rupees has been invested towards the state after signing MoU in the Investment Summit. Welcome speech was delivered by the secretary of industry and commerce department Dr. P. K. Goyal. Saplings were handed over to the guests in the programme.

Assistance to 20 fish farmers in Jirania

CM laid foundation stone for paved bridge over River Manu in Manikpur



Manikpur was known as a terror-ridden area. A multi-faceted development program is now being implemented in that Manikpur. Development work is being carried out from the city to the remote areas for the overall welfare of the citizens at all levels, rising above all kinds of narrowness, enunciated chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after laying the foundation stone of paved bridge over River Manu in Manikpur. In a programme organized at Manikpur Bazar ground, besides laying the foundation stone for paved bridge the chief minister also officially inaugurated three other paved bridges between Chawmanu and Chailengta. These paved bridges were built at Durgacherra, Gurucharancherra and Hezacherra.

Then the chief inister visited the bamboo bridge that connects Manikpur and

Debacherra. Talking to the local people he enquired about their problems in commuting in the past days. It is to be noted that this bridge will be constructed at the estimated cost of 500.33 lakh whereas 3 paved bridges between Chailengta to Chawmanu were built spending 1003.68 lakh rupees.

The chief minister in the programme said, a bunch of plans is being implemented for the overall development of the long neglected Manikpur. Rising above any kind of narrowness, the government is working with priority to provide civic services with transparency and equal decentralization in development. These Pucca bridges will emerge as one of the best means for development as well as communication for the people of the region. He said, the people of this region had to suffer due to lack of successful implementation of unplanned development in previous days. The present government is implementing developmental work plans even in the remote areas.

MP Rebati Tripura in the programme said, developmental works are being implemented in few selected blocks under

Dhalai district on priority basis that were neglected in the yesteryears. Job transfers in these areas earlier used to be perceived as a sort of punishment. But at present, the whole picture of these areas is changing due to overall development being brought. As a result, employees are no longer hesitant to be transferred to these regions. Others present in the programme were MLA Sambhulal Chakma, MDC Hanskumar Tripura, and Dhalai District Magistrate Govekar Mayur Ratilal.

Assistance to SHGs in Karbook Block by TRLM

Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission is providing financial assistances to different women-run Self Help Groups of Karbook Block.
