Foundation stone for mini-stadium laid at Charilam

Today the deputy chief minister Jishnu Dev Varma laid the foundation of a ministadium near Charilam market. Addressing the crowd there the deputy chief minister said, after 30 long years, this dream of the people of Charilam is going to be fulfilled.

This mini-stadium will be constructed with the CSR fund of NTPC. An amount of Rs. 1.37 crore will be spent in this project. The foundation laying ceremony was also attended by the MD of NTCP Dr. M.S. Koley, SDM of Bishalgarh sub-division Jayanta Chakraborty, BDO Joydip Chakraborty, the executive engineer of RD, Bishramganj division Kajal De and other engineers and technical persons of TSCL.

Ponds excavated & check dams constructed for increasing fish production

Two ponds have been dug and three check dams have been constructed in Kalikhala ADC village of Kathalia block for increasing production of fish. A total of Rs. 12, 60,424 has been spent for this purpose. Under the scheme, two ponds have been excavated for two families at the cost of Rs 7, 03,944.

Moreover, three check dams have been constructed under MGNREGA during this financial year. Rs 5, 56,480 has been spent for this purpose. Three seasonal barrages have been constructed under Panchayat Development Fund for irrigation purpose in the village. Rs 28,581 has been spent for construction of each barrage at Kalikhala. Moreover, two seasonal barrages have been constructed in Ledrabari at the cost of Rs 31,788. The village office has informed this.

Buildings constructed for 20 fish farmer families in Rupaichhari

Buildings have been constructed by the fishery department for 20 poor fish farmer families of Rupaichhari block. The houses have been constructed for 10 families in Rupaichhari ADC village and 10

families in Kathalchari ADC village. Rs 1.30 lakh has been spent for construction of each house. Total 26 lakh rupees has been spent for construction of 20 houses. The fishery superintendent Ajoy Das has informed this. On the other hand, one fish farmer knowledge centre will be constructed at Satchand block for expansion of advanced and scientific fish cultivation. Rs 43, 78,137 will be spent for this purpose.

Buildings constructed for fish farmer families in Sabroom

The fishery department has built houses for the fish farmer families. Buildings have been constructed for 10 fish farmer families of Ratanmoni ADC village, 10 fish farmer families of Shakbari ADC village of Satchand block and 10 fish farmer families of Amlighat Panchayat of Powangbari block. The fishery superintendent of Satchand block Ajoy Das has informed that construction of the buildings has already been completed. Rs 1.30 lakh has been spent for construction of each house. Total 39 lakh rupees has been spent for construction of 30 houses.

30.47 k.m brick-soling road constructed in Dukli block

30.47 k.m long brick-soling road had been constructed in Dukli block under

MGNREGA scheme during the last financial year. Total 4 crore 35 lakh 76 thousand rupees had been spent for this purpose. Dukli block source has informed that brick soling was done on 69 rural roads in 25 panchayats and ADC villages of Dukli block under the scheme.

Market shed constructed in Padmabil

Different development schemes have been implemented in padmabil block with the MLA area development fund during the financial year 2019-20. Khowai Sub divisional officer of the rural development department Maheswar Debbarma has informed that one three room-market shed has been constructed at Wandalwng market in Ram Dayal bari ADC village of the block during the last financial year. Rs 41 lakh 91 thousand 265 has been spent for this purpose.

On the other hand, two passenger sheds have been constructed in Kok English Medium School in Upendranagar ADC village and Chowmuhani in Baijalbari and Lakapur in South Padmabil ADC village at the cost of Rs 6lakh 17 thousand 382. One crematorium has been constructed in North Padmabil ADC village and Ram Dayal bari ADC village. Rs 6 lakh 45 thousand 992 has been spent for this purpose.
