Rubber plantation in Kumarghat & Pecharthal under CM Rubber Mission

Under Chief Minister Rubber Mission approval has been received for raising rubber plantation over 10 ha. land under Kumarghat Tribal Rehabilitation Range and over 7 ha. land under Pecharthal Range during the current financial year. At present identification of land is going on for that. In order to raise and nurture rubber plantation over total 17 ha. area of the subdivision an amount of Rs. 19,66,999 will be spent in five years. Under the scheme under Kumarghat range 20 families will be assisted to raise rubber plantation on 0.5 ha. area each and under Pecharthal range seven families will be assisted to raise plantation over 1 ha. area each to facilitate their income generation in future. Rubber saplings will be provided by the Rubber Board.

In addition, from the Primitive Group Rehabilitation department rubber plantation is being raised over 16 ha. area with 8 ha. each in Pecharthal and Kumarghat range under a central scheme. Under this scheme each of the 16 beneficiary families will have rubber plantation over 1 ha. land. In next four

years on account of plantation and nurturing of the same Rs. 1 lakh will be spent per 0.5 ha. land. This information has been provided by the concerned office in North district.

Waste management Centre in Sabroom

A dumping ground is being made in Ward No. 1 of Sabroom Nagar Panchayat. Sabroom Nagar Panchayat has taken this initiative for setting up a waste management centre in Sabroom. The waste deposited there from different areas of Sabroom town will be converted into bio fertilizers which will help double the production of the agricultural land. This Waste Management Centre is being built investing 1 crore 50 lakh rupees. Three Garbage Segregation Centres are being built at 3 locations.

Paddy procurement in Bamutia

Paddy procurement has been done at MSP Rs. 18.68 in Bamutia block area from 17th July 17, to July 20, 2021 at Berimura HS School campus in Bamutia block. Total 253.6 MT paddy was procured from 181 farmers. MLA Krishnadhan Das ,Bamutia Panchayat Samiti Chairperson Sheela Das

Paddy procurement in Kailasahar

Paddy procurement from the farmers of Kailasahar sub division has been completed. The process continued from July 18 to July 21, 2021 under the initiative of food, civil supplies and consumer affairs department and with the assistance of agriculture and farmer's welfare department at Kailashahar FCI godown. Total 16,100 kg paddy was procured at MSP Rs. 18.68. This was informed by the agriculture and farmers welfare sector officer Sandip Pal.

Assistance for Pisciculture under CMSPY in Mungiakami block

Fish fingerings are being distributed under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana with the goal of making fish farmers self reliant. On July 20, 2021, fish farmers of Mungiakami block were distributed fish fingerlings at Chakmaghat Community Hall. The program was inaugurated by MLA Atul Debbarma. Mungiakami BAC

Chairman Sunil Debbarma, BDO of Mungiakami block Joydeb Debbarma, Teliamura sub division fisheries supervisor Bibhas Biswas were present in the program. The fish farmers will be able to earn 25 to 30 thousand rupees from 1 kani water body in a year. The fish farmers were given 500 Rohu, Catla and Mrigel fingerlings.

Assistance to 400 families in Dhalai district for animal rearing under CMSPY

In the current financial year with the initiative of ARDD, 400 families of eight blocks in Dhalai district will be given assistance for goat rearing. Among them 79 families are from Durga Chowmuni block, 52 are from Salema block, 45 are from Ambassa block, 15 are from 51 Ganganagar block, are from Dumboornagar block, 24 are from Raishyabari block, 41 are from Chawmanu block and 93 beneficiary families are from Manu block. This was informed by Dr. Rahul Dhar Purkayastha, officer-in-charge of ARDD office, Dhalai. He said that each family will be given a calf of 6-8 months spending 7 thousand 500 rupees. Total expenditure will be 30 lakh rupees.
