## Initiative to cultivate vegetables in Tulashikhar block

Initiative has been taken to cultivate winter vegetables in 65 ha land under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture in Tulashikhar agricultural sub-division area spending 25 thousand rupees in every hectare. Farmers were provided assistance to grow cabbage, chilli, tomato, brinjal, beans and radish under this scheme. # Assistance to 325 farmers for vegetable cultivation under MIDH

Financial assistance has been given to 325 farmers so far in Bishalgarh sub-division area in the current fiscal year to cultivate vegetables under Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture programme with the initiative of the horticulture and soil conservation department. ## Areca Nut farm under MGNREGA in Jampuijala

He was taken to the AGMC hospital for proper treatment. However the sincere efforts of the doctors could not save his life. Biswajit Debbarma breathed his last in the hospital. The state government has announced financial assistance of Rs. 5 lakhs to Late Biswajit Debbarma's family. The District Magistrate of North Tripura informed this yesterday.

## Health camp at Prajabahadur Malsampara

A health camp was organized by the health department at Prajabahadur Malsampara of Nonachhara ADC village on November 21. Total 32 patients were treated in the health camp. RD test of 25 persons had been done and 3 persons of them were found suffering from fever. 6 persons were suffering from severe lung disease, ARI. No stomach problem or malaria disease had been found in any person. Required medicines were provided to the patients. Doctor of Mungiakami PHC Dr. Dinku Debbarma alongwith other medical staffs were present in the health camp. Director

of the family welfare and preventive medicines department has informed this in a press release.
