National Poshan Maah: different programmes in Karbook

National Poshan Maah is being observed by Karbook subdivision social welfare and social education office through the month of September. Different programmes have been taken up as part of this. Anganwadi Workers of 113 Anganwadi centres of two blocks of the subdivision are visiting door to door for health check up of children. They are checking whether their weight and growth are proportionate to their age. Every day one egg, 200ml milk and 20 gm molasses are being provided to each underweight child.

Moreover, plan has been taken for raising kitchen garden in the Anganwadi centres having sufficient space. LPG connection will be provided to seven Anganwadi centres of Karbook block and four Anganwadi centres of Shilachhari block with the fund of Poshan Maah. Moreover, toilets of 113 Anganwadi centres will be renovated and drinking water connection will be provided to 20 Anganwadi centres. Moreover, as a part of Poshan Maah, brief meetings have been organized with Anganwadi workers, Asha workers and beneficiaries in 12 sectors of the subdivision. CDPO, Janmejoy Chakma of Karbook ICDS project has informed this.

1, 96,392 mandays generated under MGNREGA in Padhmabil block

1,96,392 Mandays have been generated under MGNREGA in 17 ADC villages of Padmabil block up to 16th September of the current financial year. Number of registered families in the block is 8936. Among them, 7804 families have availed employment. Rs 4, 12, 42,320 has been spent for this purpose. Land leveling, construction of canal for irrigation purpose, renovation of rural road and plantation programmes schemes are being implemented in ADC villages under the scheme.
