Different development works implemented in Boxanagar

9277 Farmers under PMFBY in Jirania

9,277 Farmer have been registered under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in Jirania agricultural sub division. As a result, 1121.68 ha. land has come under the scheme. out of that 530.4 ha. land belonging to 4,172 farmers of Jirania block, 311.2 ha land belonging to 2,204 farmers of Belbari block and 280.08 ha land belonging to 2,901 farmers of Old Agartala block have come under the scheme. Water connection to 43,351 houses in West district

Water connections are being given in rural areas of West district under Jal Jeevan Mission. In addition, 14 deep tube wells have been installed in different locations of the district in present financial year and 55 Small bore tube wells have been installed. Setting up of iron removal plant has been completed under a deep tube well project.

73,673 families get assistance under CM Special Covid Relief Package

73 thousand 673 families of Antyodaya, priority households and deserving APL families in South district were given one time financial assistance of 1 thousand rupees each under Chief Minister Special Covid Relief Package.
