

Preparatory measures for disaster management in Dharmanagar

As a preparatory measure for disaster management, a mock drill was held yesterday at Chandrapur under Dharmanagar Municipal Council area. The preparatory exercise was jointly organized by the North Tripura district and Dharmanagar sub-divisional administration. Personnel from the fire service and police and Red Cross Society took part in this exercise. Apart from the

officials of the concerned departments, many local people were also present there.

Assistance for kitchen garden

Assistance has been provided to 56 farmers of Tablabari, Sonatala, Chebri and Gourangatilla under Radhacharan Nagar village of Khowai subdivision for raising kitchen garden. The initiative was taken jointly by Divyoday Agriculture Research Centre at Chebri and ICAR at Lembuchera. For this purpose seeds of different vegetables like pumpkin, bean, cucumber, arhar etc. were provided.

Morover, under the project 2 ha. land has been brought under vegetable cultivation. A total of Rs. 25,000 has been spent in supply of vegetable seeds, informed the representative of Divyoday Agriculture Research Centre Ardhendu Chakraborty.

RD activities in Tepania block

Under the aegis of rural development department construction and renovation work is going on in different gram panchayats of Tepania block during the 2019-20 financial year. Under the programme one RCC road has been constructed in Amtali gram panchayat spending Rs. 11,17,785. One road has been constructed in Dhwanjanagar gram

panchayat spending Rs. 9,33,000. Besides, in West Dhwanjanagar gram panchayat one RCC box culvert is being constructed. An amount of Rs. 34,86,608 will be spent in this work.

One RCC road is being constructed in Ward no. 2 of Amtali panchayat for which expenditure has been calculated at Rs. 14,15,118. In addition, spending Rs. 15,75,390 construction of a soil conservation dam is going on in Dhwanjanagar gram panchayat. Udaipur RD department source has informed this.

Drinking water connections to 5610 families in Hrishyamukh

Drinking water connections have been provided to 1368 families of Hrishyamukh block under Atal Jaldhara Scheme during the last financial year. Target was set for providing 800 drinking water connections under the scheme in the last year. The office of the executive Engineer of DWS department, Belonia has informed this.

11434 farmers benefit under PM Kisan

11434 Farmers of Panisagar and Jubarajnar blocks under Panisagar agriculture subdivision have been registered under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi.

Each farmer has received Rs 6000 in three installments. Among them, 4925 farmers have received money of 1st installment, 4867 farmers have received money of 2nd installment and 4120 farmers have received money of 3rd installment. 6476 farmers have been registered in Jubarajnar block. Among them, 6302 farmers have received money of 1st installment, 6258 farmers have received money of 2nd installment and 5516 farmers have received money of 3rd installment. The deputy director of agriculture and farmers welfare department Swapan Kumar Singha has informed this.

Assistance to fish farmers of Dharmanagar for Pabda cultivation

Assistance will be provided by Dharmanagar subdivisional fishery office to 12 fish farmers of Kadamtala, Kalachhara, Jubarajnar blocks and one fish farmer of Dharmanagar Municipal Council. Fish feed, oil cake, lime, protein feed and fingerlings will be provided to the fish farmers for this purpose. Rs 32,900 will be spent for each fish farmer for this purpose. Rs 4 lakh 27 thousand 700 in total will be spent. Subdivision fishery superintendent Bijoy Roy has informed this.
