

LPG Connection to Anganwadis in Salema block

With the joint initiative of Kamalpur Nagar Panchayat and Salema ICDS, LPG connections were given to Anganwadi Centres for providing food to the children through Rastriya Poshan Abhiyan. The program was inaugurated by the food and civil supplies minister Manoj Kanti Deb at Nazrul Bhawan in Kamalpur. He said this program is being held at Anganwadi levels. Gradually stoves and gas cylinders will be given to every Anganwadi Centre in the sub-division. 2 LPG gas cylinders and 1 gas stove were distributed to 72 Anganwadi Centres of Salema ICDS project and 10 Kamalpur Nagar Panchayat spending 5,750 rupees for each Anganwadi centre. Kamalpur sub-division has total 366 Anganwadi centres. The program was presided over by the Kamalpur Nagar Panchayat Chairperson Prashants Sinha.

Training in farmer's school in Bishalgarh

With the initiative of farmers' welfare and agriculture department, training in farmer's school is being given from 11th November in Madhupur, Bishalgarh, Bishramganj and Charilam areas of Bishalgarh sub-division. Training is being

given on organic farming, crop cultivation, protection of crops from monkeys, winter crop cultivation etc. On the other hand, Safai Abhiyan was practised in Ramchara bazar, Bashtali bazar, Ramnagar bazar, Rangmala bazar, Kasba Kalibari area, Harihardola bazar and Kenaniya bazar of the sub-division in last October under the Integrated Watershed Management Programme. 3 lakh 44 thousand 797 man-days under MGNREGA in Tepania block

3 lakh 44 thousand 797 man-days have been generated so far under MGNREGA in Tepania block spending 7 Cr 98 lakh 31 thousand rupees. Ponds were excavated, drains were repaired, roads were repaired and constructed, water sources were created through this benefitting 9 thousand 828 families. Betel nut plantation in Jampuijala under MGNREGA

Orchard of betel nut will be raised by the agriculture a farmers' welfare department in 44 hectare land of Jampuijala subdivision under MGNREGA. 133 families will benefit under the scheme. Rs 65.83 lakh will be spent for this purpose. 18,480

mandays will be generated under the scheme. Jampuijala agriculture superintendent Kingshuk Debbarma has informed this.

New water body in West District under PMKSY

22 new water bodies were made and 9 old ponds were renovated under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana in West District in the fiscal year 2020-21. Pipes have been given to 23 farmers for irrigation facilities. 170 power tillers and 41 pump sets were distributed among the farmers of Jirania, Mandai, Hezamara, Mohanpur and Dukli areas of West District. Total 16,589 farmers benefitted under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi in West District. 3 Cr 31 lakh 78 thousand rupees was spent in this.
