

87 Houses being constructed in Kanchanpur ADC village under PMAY

Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) houses are being constructed for 87 poor families in Kanchanpur ADC village of Laljuri block during the 2019-20 financial year. So far 33 houses have been completed. Work is in progress for rest 54 houses. An amount of Rs. 1.30 lakh has been fixed as cost of each unit house. This information has been given by the Kanchanpur ADC village committee office.

Boro paddy being cultivated in 450 hectare land of Tulashikhar

A target has been set for cultivation of Aush paddy in 450 hectare land under Tulashikhar agriculture subdivision during the financial year 2020-21. Paddy has already been cultivated in 110 hectare land. Paddy has been cultivated in 5 hectare land through SRI system. A target has been set for cultivation of high yielding paddy in 2120 hectare land during Aman season in the current financial year. Among these, paddy will be cultivated in 298 hectare land through SRI system. Rs 11.67 lakh will be spent in the scheme.

A target has been set for cultivation of hybrid paddy in 230 hectare land at the

cost of Rs 17.25 lakh. Boro paddy has been cultivated in 178 hectare land during the financial year 2019-20. Among these, paddy has been cultivated in 128 hectare land through SRI system at the cost of RS 9.30 Lakh. The office of Tulashikhar agriculture subdivision has informed this.

Drinking water connections to 6120 families of Hrishyamukh block

Drinking water connections have been provided to 1640 families of Rajnagar block under Atal Jaldhara Scheme during the last financial year. A target was set for providing drinking water connections to 750 families of the block under the scheme. The office of the executive engineer of DWS department, Belonia has informed that drinking water connections have been provided to 6120 families of the block under the scheme during the current year.

Houses constructed for 40 fish farmer families in Dharmanagar

House has been construted by the fishery department for 40 fish farmer families of Dharmanagar subdivision during the financial year 2019-20. Among the beneficiaries, 10 families are from Mangalkhali gram panchayat in

Rs one lakh thirty thousand has been spent for construction of each house. Rs 52 lakh in total has been spent. The Dharmanagar subdivision office of the fishery superintendent has informed this.

14,666 MT paddy produced in Tepania block

Paddy has been cultivated in 4336 hectare land of Tepania block in Aush, Aman and Boro seasons during the financial year 2019-20. Total 14,666 MT paddy has been produced. Of this, Aush paddy has been cultivated in 180 hectare land and 448 MT paddy has been produced. Aman paddy has been cultivated in 2056 hectare land and 6840 MT paddy has been produced. Boro paddy has been cultivated in 2100 hectare land and 7377 MT paddy has been produced. Matabari agricultural subdivision office has informed this.

Assistance provided to 11 families for mixed pisci culture

Assistance will be provided to 11 fish farmers of Khowai block And Khowai Municipal Council area under mixed pisci culture scheme for increasing production of fishes through scientific fish cultivation. 1600 different kinds of young fish will be provided to 10 fish farmers of Khowai block for cultivation of fish in 160 hectare water land. Moreover, 16000 different kinds of young fishes will be provided to one fish farmer of municipal council area for fish cultivation. Other required assistances will also be provided to the families for fish cultivation. The fishery superintendent has informed that Rs 1870 will be spent for per unit of cultivation.
