Drinking water connection to 3,52,334 houses under AJM

Drinking water connection has been provided to 3,52,334 houses free of cost under Atal Jaldhara Mission in the rural areas of the state till March 20. In the present financial year under this scheme, drinking water connection has been provided free of cost to 11,563 houses from March 1 till March 20 in the rural areas of the state. Among them, water connections were provided to 2,279 houses in North Tripura district, to 960 houses in Unakoti district, to 1,760 houses

in Dhalai district, to 616 houses in Khowai district, to 1,869 houses in West Tripura district, to 885 houses in Sepahijala district, to 1,369 houses in Gomati district and to 1,825 houses in South Tripura district. This was informed by Drinking Water & Sanitation department.

e-Card distributed under Ayushman Bharat in Labram Para

e-Cards were distributed by Ayushman Mitra to those who have not yet had their Golden cards under Ayushman Bharat scheme to deliver health care facilities to all. With the initiative of Longtharai Valley sub-divisional hospital, Golden cards were provided to total 25 families through a health camp by Ayushman Mitra Mausam Baruah and Amit Basak in Labram Para under Malidhar Panchayat of Chawmanu block on March 19 which is a far-flung hilly area nearby Indo-Bangla border. Apart from that, total 20 families from SECC census list of 2011 were identified as beneficiaries liable to get Golden cards under Ayushman Bharat scheme and necessary steps have been taken to arrange Golden cards for them.
