# New bus services in the offing for rail and air passengers

Transport department has planned to launch four new city bus services for the convenience of rail and air passengers. Principal secretary of the transport department Sriram Taranikanti informed this during a press conference at the secretariat yesterday. He informed that these bus services on four routes will be scheduled on the basis of time schedule of the trains and flights. The proposed routes are Agartala rail station to airport via Nagerjala – Barjala, Agartala rail station to airport via Nagerjala -Chandrapur – GB – Secretariat, Agartala rail station to airport via Nagerjala -Radhanagar – Secretariat and the fourth route is from Chandrapur to airport.

Principal secretary Sriram Taranikanti also informed that these buses will halt at some bus stand constructed under Smart City project. He said, at present in the state in average 15 flights and 12 trains arrive and depart daily. At present 68 bus services are operational on different routes in the state. Out of these, two buses are for airport connectivity and two

buses for the secretariat. Schedule of the news buses will be displayed at all the rail stations. Additionally, plan has been taken to launch bus services on Akhaura – checkpost to Narsingarh, and Jampuijala to Chandrapur. Tender will be floated for this very soon.

## Assistance to 35 fish farmers of Khowai under RKVY
