

Water connection to 5871 houses in Dukli block

Pipeline connection has been given to 5871 houses in Dukli block in the previous financial year under Atal Jaldhara Mission. Among them water connection was given to 4101 houses of the block till January 2020-21. Water connections have been given to 880 houses in February and 890 houses in March the present year. Apart from this, under Jal Jeevan Mission scheme, 6 deep tube wells and 3 non deep tube well are being installed in different Gram Panchayats of Dukli block area. This was informed by Dukli block office.

Assistance in Pisciculture to 673 fish farmers in Dukli block

Fish fingerlings and necessary equipments for fish farming are being distributed to 673 fish farmers under different schemes in Dukli block in the financial year 2020-21 with the initiative of fisheries department. Among them, 113 fish farmers were given fish fingerlings free of cost under previous year's action plan. Under ATMA scheme, 10 fish farmers were given fish fingerlings and necessary materials for fish farming. Apart from this, 550 fish farmers were given fish fingerlings from Dukli Panchayat

Samiti Fund. This was informed by Dukli block office.

Fish fingerling distribution in Bharatchandra nagar block

To help the fish farmers become self reliant, fish fingerlings were given to 44 fish farmers of East Kalabariya Panchayat in Bharatchandra nagar block on July 23 under Chief Minister Swanirbhar Parivar Yojana. Each was given 500 Rohu, Catla and Mrigel mixed fingerlings. During the distribution, Panchayat Samiti Chairman Putul Pal Biswas, fisheries official Dipayan Roy, concerned Panchayat Pradhan Sarabindu Majumder etc were present. Total 132 beneficiary fish farmers of the Panchayat will be given under the above said scheme.

Power connection to 24,957 families of Dhalai district under Saubhagya Yojana

Work has started with the target to provide free of cost power connection to 34 thousand 381 families in 8 block areas of Dhalai district under Soubhagya Yojana since 2018-19. So far 24 thousand 957 families have been given free power connections. This was informed by Electricity Corporation, Dhalai district DGM Shyamal Baidya. He said that under this scheme 2 thousand 693 families in Ambassa block were given power

connection which crossed the target to provide power connection to total 2 thousand 102 families of the block. 1 thousand 979 families were given power connection in Ganganagar block. Target was to provide power connection to total 3 thousand 624 families of the block.

3 thousand 414 families were given free power in Dumburnagar block. Target was to provide power connection to total 4 thousand 43 families of the block. 1 thousand 994 families were given power connection in Raisyabari block. Target was to provide the same to total 2 thousand 656 families of the block. 2 thousand 540 families were given power connection in Salema block. Target was to provide connection to total 5 thousand 920 families of the block. 3 thousand 277 families received power connection in Durgachowmuni block which crossed the target to provide connection to total 3 thousand 172 families. 5 thousand 254 families were given free power connection in Manu block. Target was to give the connection to 7 thousand 395 families of the block. 2 thousand 806 families were given free power connections in Chawmanu block. Target was to provide the connection to total 5 thousand 469 families.

**17,091 farmers under Pradhan
Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana**

Total 17 thousand 91 farmers' land were brought under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in the current season. Among them 4 thousand 762 farmers are from

Boxanagar block and Sonamura Nagar Panchayat, 3 thousand 695 from Mohanbhog block, 2 thousand 949 from Kathalia block and 5 thousand 685 farmers from Nalchar block. This was informed by the agriculture and farmer's welfare department, Sonamura sub division office.

Flood control dam in Jirania block

In the present financial year, 1 lakh 90 thousand 789 mandays have been generated through 305 different developmental works under MGNREGA in different Gram Panchayats of Jirania block. 14 flood control dams are being built under the scheme. 2 dams in Bisrambari ADC village, 5 in Joynagar Gram Panchayat, 1 in Krishnanagar Gram Panchayat, 4 in Madhya Debendranagar Gram Panchayat, 1 in West Barjala ADC village and 1 dam is being built in West Majlishpur Gram Panchayat. One pond is being excavated in each of Durganagar, Majlishpur and North Majlishpur Gram Panchayats. 1 rubber garden recharge pit is also being excavated in East Barjala Gram Panchayat. Apart from this, 210 land levelling is also being done in 13 Gram Panchayat and 6 ADC villages of the block. 77 water irrigation drainage system are being made. So far 98 thousand 576 mandays have been generated. This was informed by Jirania block office.
