TUDA projects reviewed yesterday: focus on planning according to objectives

Under the chairmanship of the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb a meeting of Urban the Tripura Planning Development Authority (TUDA) was held yesterday at the secretariat. Speaking at the meeting the chief minister said, the state government is taking various steps to promote communication and tourism industry in the state. So, planning in the state should be framed accordingly with focus on infrastructure development. He advised the TUDA also to outline its planning keeping this in view.

Giving updates on the new TUDA projects the commissioner of TUDA Dr. Shailesh Kumar Yadav informed, already foundation stone has been laid for the housing project at Vivekananda Market area and Kunjaban. Additionally the TUDA has taken up a project at the site of the old central jail at Dhaleshwar. A total of 420 flats will be built over there with an estimated project cost of Rs. 268.64 crore. TUDA is working with the target of floating tender and booking for this project. On this, the chief minister instructed TUDA to maintain quality and stipulated timeframe of construction.

On the other hand, Dr. Yadav, shedding light on the Light House project said, spending Rs. 162.50 crore flats will be constructed for the poor people under this project. Besides, an IT Park will be built on 3 acre land of the old central jail. Structural work of the administrative block and library building has been completed for the IT Park.

Other issues that found place in the discussion were – development infrastructure in seven districts with the Asian Development Bank's fund. construction of a five-star hotel in Shalbagan area in PPP model etc. The meeting was also attended by the urban secretary of development department Kiran Gitte, principal secretary Sriram Tarani Kanti, secretary of the finance department Tanushri Debbarma, director of the urban development department Dr. Sandeep Namdeo Mahatme and so on.
