#### PMAY houses in process in Karbook

With the fund allocated in the 2021-22 financial year so far 1,267 houses (out of targeted 2,177 houses) have been constructed in Karbook block under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana. Under the scheme 2,157 families have received their first installment of assistance, 1,996 families have received 2<sup>nd</sup> installment and 1,590 families have received third installment. Besides, construction work of 319 toilets has been completed and work of 91 toilets is in progress. Two community toilets are also constructed. Karbook CDPO has informed this.

The Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has approved 32 new roads for the state under PMGSY-III with an estimated cost of Rs. 214.23 crore. The total length of these roads will be 231.64 km. Out of this total length of roads, four roads will be constructed in North Tripura with a length of 21.919 km, one road in Dhalai (12.877), eight roads in Khowai district (55.811 km.), six roads in South Tripura district (50.077 km), and 11 roads in West Tripura district (78.531 km.). Nano technology is being used for 122.71 km road and to ensure quality and durability of roads FDR will be applied to 250 km. road under the scheme, informed

chief engineer (PMGSY) of PWD Bimal Das in a press release.

In the press release Sri Das has also informed that PMGSY –III basically focuses on strengthening the existing road connectivity between habitations and markets, educational institutions, hospitals, administrative headquarters in rural areas. Under this initiative total 775 km. road will be developed.

## Jal Jeevan Mission : drinking water connection to 390473 houses

Domestic drinking water connection has been provided to 390473 houses in rural areas of the state under Jal Jeevan Mission till now. Drinking water connection has been provided to total 3499 houses during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. Among these, 573

drinking water connections in North Tripura district, 557 connections in West Tripura district, 168 connections in Unakoti district, 459 connections in Sepahijala district, 856 connections in Dhalai district, 525 connections in Gomati district, 189 connections in Khowai district and 177 connections in South Tripura district have been provided. DWS department has informed this.

### Distribution of fingerlings among beneficiaries in Karbook

Fingerlings of different types of fish were distributed by the Karbook Subdivision office of fisheries department among the beneficiaries through a programme under action plan of the FY 2022-23 on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. Among these, 5600 fingerlings of cat fish, 700 fingerlings of prawn and 4900 fingerlings of pabda have been provided to 13 beneficiaries of Karbook block and 8 beneficiaries of Shilachhari block. Rs 61250 has been spent for this purpose. These fingerlings will be cultured in total 2.10 hectare water area of both the blocks.
