

Development works being implemental in Dasda Block

Various development works under MGNREGA are being implemented in Subhashnagar ADC village of Dasda block during the current financial year. Total 1048 mandays have been generated in the village at the cost of Rs 2 lakh 14 thousand 840. Land leveling, construction of barrage for fish cultivation etc. have been implemented under the scheme. The office of Subhashnagar ADC village committee has informed this.

6000 kg rice distributed among Divyangans in Gomati district

Total 6000 Kg rice has been distributed free of cost among the Divyangans by Gomati Zilla Parishad in association with district administration to prevent spread of Covid-19 virus during the lockdown period in the state. The programme was inaugurated by Sabhadhipati of Gomati Zilla Parishad Swapan Adhikari at Shalgarah High School of Udaipur on May, 24. It is noteworthy that the Divyangans have received 1100 Kg rice in Matabari block, 1100 Kg rice in Kakraban block, 1400 Kg rice in Tepania block, 400 Kg rice in Killa block, 1000 Kg rice in Amarapur

block 400 Kg rice in Ampa block, 600 Kg rice via Karbook block and 600 Kg rice in Shilachhari block. 5 Kg rice has been provided to each person. Sabhadhipati of Gomati Zilla Parishad Swapan Adhikari has informed that total 1200 Divyangans have benefited from this initiative.

Small Saving Scheme collects Rs 25 crore in Gomati district

Total Rs 25 crore 25 lakh 25 thousand 219 has been collected under Small Savings Scheme in Gomati district during the financial year 2019-20. The target of collection was Rs 25 crore for this tenure. Gomati District Small Savings officer has informed that Rs 21 crore 9 lakh 50 thousand 700 in Udaipur subdivision, Rs 3 crore 21 lakh 96 thousand 690 in Amarapur subdivision and Rs 93 lakh 77 thousand 829 in Karbook subdivision have been collected.

Various assistances provided to fish farmers in Khowai district

Financial assistance has been provided to 2653 fish farmers in Khowai district during the last two financial years for promotion of fish cultivation. Total Rs 44 lakh 12 thousand has been spent for this purpose. Training has been provided to 1654 fish farmers at the cost of Rs 5 lakh 40

thousand. Assistance has been provided to 405 fish farmers for scientific fish cultivation under Rashtriya Krishi Vikash Yojana at the cost of Rs 56 lakh 5 thousand. Financial assistance as flood relief under NDRF fund has been provided to 5378 fish farmers at the cost of Rs 21 crore 71 lakh 77 thousand. Assistance has been provided to 574 fish farmers under Neel Kranti Scheme at the cost of Rs 43 lakh 91 thousand. Houses have been constructed for 160 fish farmers at the cost of Rs 1 crore 8 lakh. Financial assistance has been provided by the tribal welfare department to 98 rural poor tribal fish farmers at the cost of Rs. 26 lakh 22 thousand during this period. Preparation for distribution of remaining text books in schools

Education Department has taken preparation for distribution of those text books which are yet reach the students due to covid-19 situation. Education minister Ratan Lal Nath said this in a press meet on May 24, 2020. He informed that text books will be supplied to the students before academic process sets in place in the schools. He also informed that primary level 25, 37,107 text books have already been supplied. Similarly, 1, 51,000 text books for class-IX have been distributed. Text books of 8 subjects out of 9 subjects for class X have arrived in the state. Text books of 15 subjects out of 29 subjects for class XII have already arrived. He said that arrangement will be made for supply of remaining books immediately. He informed that shortage of teacher is existing in some schools. Education department has taken initiative for posting teachers in these schools. Same initiative will be taken in TTAADC area also.
